In The Name of God Amen the fifth Day of February in the year of Our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and Sixty nine, I Thomas Jewell of Beauford County in the Province of North Carolina being Sick in Body but of Good perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God and calling to remembrance the uncertain Estate of this Transitory Life and being Desirous to settle in Order as make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first and Principally I Commend my Soul to almighty God my Creator assuredly believing that I shall receive full Pardon and free remission of all my Sins and be Saved by the Precious Death and Merits of my Blessed Savior and Redeemer Christ Jesus and my Body to the Earth from which I was taken to be buried in such decent and Christian like manner as to my Ex^{rs} and Ex^{ts} hereafter named shall Be thought meet and Convenient and as touching

my Worldly Estate as the Lord in Mercy hath Lent me my Will is Expressed and first I do Revoke renounce frustrate and make void all Wills by me formerly made and declared except this my last Will and Testament

Item my mind Will Desire is that my Beloved wife shall have my negroe fellow named Brist for the use of bringing up the Children and if he should prove Sassy she shall have the disposing of him to suit herself as she thinks proper

I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife five Beades and furniture for the Servis of her Children likewise I give and bequeath all my Estate within and without holly and Solly to my beloved wife and if she should Marry she then shall have a third of the Estate after Bringing up the Children I give and bequeath to my beloved wife the manner plantation whereon I now live During her life and at her Death to my Son James and his heirs for ever and if he don't see fit to live on it it shall go to my Son John likewise I do bequeath to my beloved wife one negroe Wench named Liner during her pleasure likewise I do love my wife holly and Solly Ex^{rs}

Heirs and assigns forever - and further my Will is that the Plantation
that I purchased of Mr Alexander Stewart known by the name of
Cooksons old field be sold and the money arising therefrom shall be
applied towards paying my Debts and if any overplus to be Divided
as hereafter mentioned

Item I give and Bequeath all Singular the remainder of my Estate
to be Equally Divided between my Wife Mary Phillips my Sons John
Phillips, Henry Phillips, William Phillips, & Isaac Phillips, my Daughter
Elizabeth Phillips, Ann Phillips and Sarah Phillips, to them and their
Heirs forever.

And last of all I nominate and constitute and appoint my beloved
friend Henry Bommer to be my Sole Executor of this my Last Will
and Testament

that is not before Given. I also appoint my Son Colman Roe my Sole
Exatr of this my last Will and Testament. I witness I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this Thirteenth Day of Oct^r 1770
