Will of
Alex Robeson

June the 7th 1895.
I Alexander Robeson do make my will to my
brothers and sisters of one hundred acres of land
joining Linous Robeson and James M. Robeson
and others, running from Cape Fair's river out
back. This land is to be divided between Hes-
sick S. Robeson and Fred Robeson and Lydia Robeson
and Rachel Robeson and Lydia and Rachel to have from
the road to the river, and Rachel to have the house part
after mother's and father's decease and Lydia to have
the other part and Hessian and Fred to have from the road
out back.

name aforesaid, declare the said paper writing as sub-
scribed by him and exhibited to be his last will and
testament and the deponents who are dead did
thereupon subscribe their names at the end of said
will as attesting witnesses thereto and at his re-
quest and in the presence of the said testator.

And these deponents further saith that at the
said time when the said testator subscribed his
name to the said last will as aforesaid and the
time of the deponent subscribing his name as
an attesting witness thereto as aforesaid the said
Alexander Robeson was of sound mind and
memory, of full age to execute a will and was
not under any restraint to the knowledge, informa-
tion or belief of this deponent.
