me with I give and devise and dispose of in
the manner following.

all my wearing apparel. my negroes. my cattle money
and household furniture with all other my goods
and chattels. after my lawful debts are paid I give
to my amiss William Smith a piece of land that
was given to me by my Father. but in case my
daughter Mary McRee should die before she is thirty
one years of age and should have no lawful heir
of her own body. behind her. then I do give
and bequeath to my amiss William Smith. Cousin
to my assigns John Smith the whole of my estate
to him his heirs and assigns. whom I make sole
Executors of this my last will and Testament
with full power to sell or exchange my part of
my estate as shall think proper. or most ad-
vantageous for the good or benefit of my
daughter whom I also charge to pay all my
lawful debts or any other instruments of writing
witnessing and confirming this and no other to be
my last will and Testament.

I will and bequeath to my second son Charles
Howard one Negro man named Charles.

I will and bequeath to my third daughter
Mary Howard one negro woman named Hannah
and one Negro boy named Pompey and one son
Mary named Phillips.

I will and bequeath to my third son James
Howard one negro man named Tom.

I bequeath to my son William Howard a Bed
and bedding already in his possession
And I will that every one of them should receive the
same at my decease and if there is one deficient the
other five children to make it good.

And I will that every one of my children should have
one Room and three floors, divided into six equal
divisions. Many, Hannah, Furniture that is not before named
and all my horses that is not named all my plantation
tools and all my Legs and being put in equal lots
every Child shall draw their own lot.

And I also will that my Books be divided in the
same manner.

I will that my lands be sold to the highest
bidders and the money that it brings to be equally
divided among my three sons to wit - William Howard
Charles Howard and James Howard and all my
Cattle that is not already given away to be equally
divided between my three daughters to wit - Sarah
Howard, Eugenia Howard, and Mary Howard, and

I will and appoint my sons William Howard and
Charles Howard Executors to this my last Will and Test-
ament.
