Secondly

I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Simpson one bed and furniture, one bureau, one folding table, and two Windsor chairs to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

I do appoint and ordain my friends William Johnson, Magazine Dranghan and David Lloyd Executors of this my last will and Testament.

I give and bequeath to Marian Shaw five pounds North Carolina Currency.

The remainder of my estate both Real and personal not heretofore uttered away I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Lammond to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I hereby make and ordain my worthy friends Duncan McCall and David McKeehan Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
