Mill Pond &c containing fifteen hundred and eighty acres more or less. be sold immediately after my decease by my Executors Hereafter mentioned as a part of my effects and the proceeds to go to my daughter Eliza abett Ellis. To give with all my lot in Eliz. abettown not herein enumerated to her and her heirs forever.

Deeds. It is my Will and desire that my perishable property consisting of Negroes, Stock, Furniture, Farming utensils &c. be equally divided between my son James Samuel Ellis and my daughter Eliza and Ellis share and share alike.

I Herely make and ordain my worthy friends John McRay, John Orr, and James Samuel Ellis, Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Edward Fitzrandolph the whole of my plantation and all other of my land in the County of Bladen, also I give and bequeath to my son Edward, the following Negroes to wit, Luce, Juba, Phineas, Dany, Rhetoe, Portia: Parney, John and Peter, with their families and upon income likewise all my stocks of every kind, all my plantation tools Blacksmith tools

distillery, house hold and kitchen furniture all my
 notes Bonds and Book accounts, all my Carriages &
 him the said Edwards, his heirs and assigns forever.
 I give to my grandson Benjamin P. Randolph
 the first becoming negroes, Mike, Moses, Adam, and Mary
 with her future increase, to be delivered to him when
 he arrives to the age of twenty one to him and his
 heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my grand son Edward
 Lawrence McKee, one negro male named Nora
 with her present and future increase to be del-
 ivered to him at the age of twenty one, worth less
 less if my grand son, Lawrence, McKee should die
 before he arrives at the age of twenty one, the said
 Negro Woman and, her present and future increase shall
 return and be divided among my three children -
 Edward, Quetz, and Gained.

I give and bequeath unto my grand son Benjamin
 Randolph White, one negro girl named, Nancy, the
 daughter of Mary, nevertheless if my grand son
 Benjamin Randolph White should die before
 he arrives to the age of twenty one, the said girl,
 Nancy, be given to my daughter Gained.

I give to my son in law James McKee, Jr.
 Shillings Sterling.

I give to my daughter Quetz, the following negroes
 Joe Cook, Adam, with her present and future increase
 along with her future increase, Jennie, with her present
 and future increase to her the said Quetz, her heirs
 and assigns forever.

I give to my daughter Gained the following negroes
 Charon, Ben, and Mary, with her present and future
 increase, Nancy excepted, also extra with her pres-
 ent and future increase to her the said Gained and
 heirs and assigns forever.

I do hereby constitute and appoint Edwards
 P. Randolph, Malcom McKee, and George
 Knowles, my true and lawful Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and
 disannulling all other former Wills by me made

Will and Testament.
