It is also my will that my Executors keep my negroes on the plantation with all my stock of every kind and plantations tools &c.

It is also my desire that the Saw mill with the plantation be worked under the direction

Item I give to my son Thomas one cow and steer, ten head of hogs, and one feather bed and furniture and one three year old gray mare and one half of my household goods.

Item I give to my son River one Airedale mare ten years old and one cow and calf and ten head of hogs and one bed and furniture and one half of my household goods and all of my Cooper's tools

I give to my sons Thomas and River Jordan all my farming tools and saddle.
 Lastly I nominate and appoint my friends Jesse Jones and John Currie Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking every other will or wills heretofore by me made.

 I also bequeath that if the said Lelia Memory should die before the said Sarah Memory that the said Sarah Memory shall heir the said property bequeathed to my daughter Lelia Memory.
 Also I give to my son Thomas Memory and my daughter Ellender Ward each one hundred acres of land to be drawn for as aforesaid out of said tract of land.
 Also I bequeath that my stock of cattle, hogs, sheep, plantation utensils and all my other property to be sold at public auction on six months credit and when the money is collected that it be equally divided between my said wife Sarah Memory, Lelia Memory, Thomas Memory and Ellender Ward.
 And I do hereby utterly revoke and disallow all other wills and bequests ratifying this and no other to be my last will and Testament this day one thousand eight hundred and six.
