Hanna, during her life and at her decease the
said Much to be the property of my son Philmore
Bryan and his heirs forever, and the income of
said Much during my Wifes life to be equally divided
among my children.

I desire that my loving wife Jane Bryan and
Thomas Orrin see that this my last will and
Testament be properly executed making and
discharge all former Wills whatant.

that all men must die, I have thought proper
to make this my last will and Testament.

That is to say first of all I recommend my Soul

of my Executors.

I give and bequeath to my well beloved Sister
Elizabeth Lock one bed and furniture also one
negroon Cat.

I give and bequeath unto my three Sons
Benjamin, Joseph & William Cooper sons of
Joseph Cooper deceased all my land and all
my money notes and accounts.

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or money arising therefrom, also my wearing apparel
also one clock and watch and my other available
effects, all my Tools Carpenter and Blacksmith with
my Sea faring instruments and books shall be equally
divided between Benjamin Joseph and William Cooper
when they come to the age of majority according to
the direction of my Executors and further my mind
and this is that my Executors shall take my house
in his possession and for him to keep and value and
sell at any time when he shall think proper and
the money arising therefrom laying up for the use
afore said.

I further give to my Sister Elizabeth Lock one Bed
my mind and this is that Leonard Locks family keep
the Gun Shop of mine and also one Orr and two Span
old and further my Will and desire is that no inventory
shall be returned to Court.

I further appoint John Lock whole sole my
Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
