

## RECORD OF WILLS.

- 1<sup>st</sup> In the Name of God "Amen"  
 I Catherine Blue being of sound body and mind  
 do make this my last Will and Testament  
 That my Executor herein after named shall furnish  
 for body a decent burial and pay all funeral expense  
 together with my just debt. To whomsoever comes out  
 of the money that may first come into his hands as  
 a part of my estate.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and devise unto my beloved Son John F. Blue  
 His Reins and assigns forever, the entire tract of land  
 where I now reside containing One hundred and twenty  
 acres, more or less, adjoining the lands of James Brown  
 and Thomas C. Smith.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved Son John F.  
 Blue, His Reins and assigns forever, my Negro man  
 named Warwick, and my boys named Cannon, Jim,  
 and Calvin, and my Woman Jane her issue and  
 increase.
- 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son John F.  
 Blue, His Reins and assigns forever all my  
 Stock of Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Horses, and my  
 Household and Kitchen Furniture.
- 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son John F.  
 Blue, His Reins and assigns forever, all my Farming  
 implements and Plantation tools of every description.
- 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son John F.  
 Blue, His Reins and assigns forever all my provisions  
 of every description, that may be in hand at the  
 time of my death, together with the crop that  
 may be growing or may be harvested at the time  
 of my death.
- 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret  
 Clark, wife of Archl. B. Clark, His Reins and assigns  
 forever, my Negro Woman, Many, Her future issue and  
 increase.
- 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved grand  
 children John Davis Dugard, B. Catherine and  
 Elizabeth Ann Murphy, their Reins and assigns forever  
 my Negro Girl, Kitty, her issue and increase.
- I hereby appoint my Son John F. Blue my  
 Executor to this my last Will and Testament.
