Chorch Carolina

In the County of Bladen
In the State of North Carolina
I Name this White of the County and Province aforesaid
being weak and infirm in body, but of sound
and disposing memory and knowing the uncertainty
of this life do make this to be and contain my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following.
First and principally I recommend my soul to
eternal God hoping through the mediation and inter-
cession of Our blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
to inherit eternal life my body I desire to be buried
interned by my Executors herein after mentioned
and as to such worldly goods as it has pleased
God to endow me with I give devise and bequeath in
manner and form following.

I give devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter
Lucy Brown, all my Morning apparel Two Beds
No 1 & 2. Suite of Linen Curtains Half of the Kitchen
Furniture that is to say Iron pots.

And I give likewise the first Child that a mulatto
girl named Rachel shall have and if my said
daughter Lucy Brown shall die without an Heir
of her body the said Child and its income if a girl
to return to my son William Jones.

I give devise and bequeath to my beloved son William
Jones a negro man named Judy and a mulatto
girl left me by my nephew John Vernon named
Rachel.

I likewise give to my son William Jones all
my Furniture and every thing else that I shall be
possessed of which is but as yet bequeathed to him
and his heirs forever.

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my
dear son William Jones Executor and my daughter
Lucy Brown Executrix of this my last Will and
Testament thereby revoking all other Wills or
testaments or any such writing made by me here
tofore.

I Daniel Willis of the County of Bladen and
State of Chorch Carolina this the 10th day of March
1784 and in the eighth Year of the American
Independence do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament revoking all other and former
will Legacies and bequests.

First I commit my soul to Almighty God who
gave it, my body I recommend to the earth, to be
buried in decent form, at the discretion of my
Executors herein after named And as to my worldly
estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me with in this life, I give devise and dispose
of it in manner and form following.

And first I desire all my just debts may be dispa-
ged and paid.

I give and bequeath all my estate both Real
and Personal to be equally divided between my
loving wife Elizabeth Willis and my sons Daniel
John, Robert, and Jacob Willis and my daughters
Sarah, Elizabeth Diana, Amelia and Ann, their
heirs and assigns forever.

And Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint
my sons Daniel and John Willis and Thomas
Rosen Cogins to be my whole & sole Executors

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of this my last Will and Testament revoking all former Will or Wills by me heretofore had made or done.

In the name of God "Amen"
This sixt^h day of October 1772. I Josiah Wilson
of Bladen County and Province of North Carolina being
sick and near of body but of perfect mind and
memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of
human life, and knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die. Do make this my last Will and
testament. First and principally I commit my soul
to God that gave it. My ^{body} I commit to the earth to be
decently interred at the discretion of my Executors here
in after named. as to my temporal estate I beg leave
and dispose of it in the following manner.

My Will is that all my just debts and funeral
expenses be paid and discharged as soon as possible
after my decease.

To give to my son George Wilson a piece or part
of a survey of land containing One hundred and
Twenty acres of land. being the one half there-

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Six hundred and forty acres granted and patented
to Capt George Martha as by the said Patent may more
fully and at large appear. To him the said George
Wilson his heirs and assigns forever.

I also give grant and bequeath to my son
Atubro Wilson Three hundred and twenty acres of land
between the above said land and Dr Thomas Stalls
land being granted and patented to John Davis Bryn as
by the said Patent may more fully and at large appear
To him the said Atubro Wilson his heirs and assigns
forever.

I also give unto my son John Wilson a negro boy
named Sam unto him the said John Wilson his
heirs and assigns forever. And my further is
that if either of the above said sons should depart this
life before the age of twenty one years. That his part be
divided between the other two.

My will is that the remaining part of my estate
consisting of one negro man and one negro woman
Horses Cattle Household furniture and article
whatsoever of my said Estate be divided be-
tween my beloved wife and our five daughters viz
Sarah, Deborah, Mary Ann, and Elizabeth to
them and their heirs forever. which said division to
be when my Executors shall find it necessary.

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint William
Falter and John Falter to be my whole and sole
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
And I do declare this and no other to be my
last Will and Testament.
