forty six, make and publish this my last will
and testament, in manner and form following

It is my wish and desire that all my
just debts and funeral expenses be paid.

I give and bequeath all of my Estate that
have not been previously given away, by deeds
of gift both Real and Personal, and also all
property and things that may in law or Equity
belong to me, to be equally divided in five equal
shares, and my son William Shaw to have one
share, my son Randall Shaw to have one share
my son Daniel Shaw to have one share, and
the children of my son Duncan Shaw to have
one share and my son Archibald to have the
other share, all to share and share alike
And I do hereby nominate and appoint my sons
Daniel Shaw and Archibald Shaw, Executors
to this my last will and testament

and her heirs of her body forever.

And I do hereby appoint and ordain my two sons
William Spritt and Roberts O. Spritt and my
worthy friend Raiford Fisher, Executors to this my
last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills
by me made,

scribing witnesses who were present and requested by
me to be witnesses.
