I do give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Sutton all my lands stock and household furniture except one piece of land lying on Crawley Swamp which I do give and bequeath unto my beloved brother Christopher Sutton and heirs.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Sutton the following named negroes Phill. Adam. Mall. Dall. Willy. Phillis. David. Sandy. Tom. Albert and Artha.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Elizabeth Sutton one Negro girl by the name of Anna.

I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Jane Sutton one Negro girl named Louisa.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Margaret Sutton one Negro girl named Tomer.

Then I do give and bequeath unto my grand son John Sutton one negro boy named Jacob and if one of the overwise should have female child, she I do give and bequeath unto my grand son John Sutton.

In testament of which I do make and ordain this my last will and Testament.

I Elizabeth Pemberton of the County of Bladen and State of North Carolina being of perfect mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament in manner following.

I give devise and bequeath to Thomas Brown Esquire and John B. Brown the following property to wit one Negro Woman named Maria and child Chauncy to them the said Thomas Brown Esquire and John B. Brown Esquire and their and each of their heirs Executors or administrators upon their special trust and confidence that they the said Thomas Brown Esquire and John B. Brown Esquire and administrators of the said Thomas Brown Esquire and John B. Brown Esquire shall use and benefit of my daughter Elizabeth, Neg. Sophia Pemberton, Abigail Pemberton and Chauncy Pemberton that is to say the said Woman Maria to the sole and separate use of my daughter Sophia and said child Chauncy to the sole and separate use of my daughter Elizabeth Neg. and the next child which the said Woman Maria may have to the sole and separate use of my daughter Abigail and the next child which the said Woman Maria may have to the sole and separate use of my daughter Chauncy and all the other children which said Woman may have to the sole use and benefit of my daughter Sophia, or and during their natural lives and then for the use and benefit of their children respectively to them or each of them their or each of their heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my daughters above mentioned my first fatherbeds furniture share and share alike to them and to their own proper use and benefit and for them to dispose of as they or either of them may think best.

And all the remaining part of my property of my description after paying my just debts should any be left I give to my son Thomas Pemberton and to his heirs and assigns forever.

RECORD OF WILLS.

I Margaret Sutton Widow of John Sutton being of sound mind and memory thanks be to god do this day publish and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following - viz

I give and bequeath to Catherine Ann Sutton and the heirs of her body, the illegitimate of my grand daughter Ann Sutton two negers coat and Stove and packed bed and furniture.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Sarah Ann Melvin four cows and calves, one bedstead feather bed and furniture half a dozen cups and saucers, half a dozen of plates, one dish two chairs one table, one large iron pot one tea kettle three shins and tongue.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Elizabeth Melvin four pewter plates one dish one brass candle stick, one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to my grand son John Sutton one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to Eliza Russ one cow and calf one of.

I give and bequeath to Patrick Kelly one gale of oxen.

I give to my daughter Ann Sutton four negers Anna Archibald, Moll and Daniel during her natural life and after her death to be equally divided among the surviving heirs of her body should Catherine Ann Sutton the illegitimate child of my grand daughter Jane Sutton die without issue, I give and bequeath that part bequeathed to her, to my daughter Ann Sutton and the surviving heirs of her body.

Should Sarah Ann Melvin die leaving no issue I give and bequeath all that part bequeathed to her, to my grand daughter Sarah Jane Sutton after my lawful debts are paid out of the unbequeathed part of my estate all that may remain I give to my daughter Ann Sutton.

And I do hereby appoint my friends James Jeromathie and David Lloyd Executors to this my last Will and Testament.
