I do give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Sutton the following named negro Phill, Adam, Moll, Dell, Milly, Phillis, David, Sandy, Tom, Alfred and Arthur.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Elizabeth Sutton one Negro girl by the name of Anna.

I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Jane Sutton one Negro girl named Louisa.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved grand daughter Margaret Sutton one Negro girl Anna.

Then I do give and bequeath unto my grand son John Sutton one Negro boy named Jack and if one of the aforesaid should have female child, she I do give and bequeath unto my grand son John Sutton.

I give devise and bequeath to Thomas Brown Esqur and John B. Brown the following property to-wit one Negro Woman named Maria and child Charcy to them the said Thomas Brown Esqur and John B. Brown Esqur and their and each of their heirs Executors or administrators upon this special trust and confidence that they the survivor or survivors and the executors and administrators of the survivors who hold all the aforesaid property in trust for the sole and separate use and benefit of my daughter Elizabeth Rea, Sophia Pumberton, Abigail Pumberton and Charcy Pumberton that is to say the said Woman Maria to the sole and separate use of my daughter Sophia and said child Charcy to the sole and separate use of my daughter Elizabeth Rea and the next child which the said Woman Maria may have to the sole and separate use of my daughter Abigail and the next child which the said Woman Maria may have to the sole and separate use of my daughter Sophia for and during their natural lives and then for the use and benefit of their children respectively or them or each of them their or each of their heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my daughters above mentioned my first Fatherless furniture share and share alike to them and to their own proper use and benefit and for them to dispose of as they or either of them may think best.

And all the remaining part of my property of my description after paying my just debts shored am left I give to my Son Thomas Pumberton and to his heirs and assigns forever. I sign sealed and declared this 11th day of June 1821

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter
 Sarah Ann Melvin four cows and calves, one leathered
 featherbed and furniture half a dozen cups and
 saucers, half a dozen of plates, one dish, two chams,
 one table, one large iron pot one tea kettle, trout, shawl
 and longs.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter
 Elizabeth Melvin four pewter plates, one dish, one brass
 candle stick, one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to my grand son John Sutton
 one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to Eliza Russ one cow and calf
 one ox.

I give and bequeath to Patrick Kelly one yoke of oxen
 I give to my daughter Ann Sutton four negroes Anna
 Archibald, Moll and Daniel during her natural life
 and after her decease to be equally divided among
 the surviving heirs of her body should Catharine Ann Sutton
 the illegitimate child of my grand daughter Jane
 Sutton die without issue, I give and bequeath that
 part bequeathed to her, to any daughter Ann Sutton
 and the surviving heirs of her body.

Should Sarah Ann Melvin die leaving no issue I
 give and bequeath all that part bequeathed to her to
 my grand daughter Sarah Jane Sutton after my
 lawful debts are paid out of the unqueathed
 part of my estate all that may remain I give to
 my daughter Ann Sutton.

And I do hereby appoint my friends James
 Somerville and David Lloyd Executors to this my
 last Will and Testament.
