I give to my daughter Perra Harts one shilling

 and seal the twenty second day of July in the year
 of Our Lord 1774.

In the Name of God Amen
 The 20th day of March 1784. I George Brown of
 Coladen Creek, North Carolina being weak in body
 but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given
 unto God therefore, Calling unto mind the mortality
 of my body knowing that it is appointed for all
 men once to die, do make and ordain this my last
 Will and Testament. That is to say, principally and
 first, of all.

I give and recommend my Soul into the hands
 of God that gave it, and my body I recommend to
 the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at
 the discretion of my Executors, not doubting but at the
 general resurrection I shall receive the same again
 by the mighty power of God, and as touching such
 worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
 bless me, with in this life, I give devise and dispose
 of the same in the following manner and form.

I give and bequeath unto my son
 by my late wife Elizabeth the third of the use of
 my land whereon I now live, and one

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negro much named Phibe and one fourth part of
 my cattle, and sheep and one third of my household
 furniture for and during her natural life or widowhood
 and if any part thereof be left at her death to
 be divided between my son George and Richard Brown
 and my daughter Mary Brown and Peggy White Brown

I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Brown two
 hundred acres of land one hundred acres at the white marsh
 and one hundred on the Hog Swamp adjoining David
 Wicks land, likewise an equal part of my cattle with the
 rest of my children to him his heirs and assigns forever

I give and bequeath to my son John Brown one
 hundred acres in Hog Swamp adjoining Samuel Smiths
 land also one negro man named David, to him
 his heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my son George Brown three
 hundred acres of land on Draining Creek adjoining
 the lands of El. Parby and also one negro man by the
 name of Murphy to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Brown
 the plantation where I now live five hundred acres be
 the same more or less, to him his heirs and assigns
 forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Ephraima
 Oliphant one negro boy named White to her and
 the lawful heirs of her body forever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Brown
 one negro girl named Lucy to be delivered to her
 at her marriage or when twenty one years of age to
 her and her heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Peggy White Brown
 one negro girl named Chloa to be delivered to her at
 her marriage or when twenty one years of age to her
 and her heirs and assigns forever.

I give the remainder of my sheep and cattle to
 my sons, John George and Richard Brown my daughter
 Ephraima Oliphant, Mary Brown and Peggy White Brown
 to be equally divided and household furniture

I give and bequeath to my son Richard
 Mary and Peggy White Brown all my house and
 for the house use,

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Then I will that my loved wife next the month of the month be ruled for her young towards schooling and bringing up Mary Brown, Aggy White Brown and my Cousin Mary Rues.

Then I do constitute make and ordain Thomas Brown John Brown and Richard Brown my Sole Executors to this my last will and Testament And I do hereby utterly disannul revoke and disavow all and any other former Testament and Legacies and bequests and Executors by me in any way before made named made or bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.

therefor. Having unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. That is to say.

Principally and first of all. I recommend my soul to God who gave it and for my body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in Christian like manner at the

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discretion of my friends and Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the might power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life. I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

Then I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Anne Barfield one feather bed and furniture and one half of my moveable property that is to say dogs carts and household goods.

Then I give and bequeath to my son Elias Barfield one hundred acres of land with the plantation I now live on and one feather bed and a pair of sheets and also the other half of my moveable estate that I have not given to my wife.

Then I give and bequeath to my son Miles Barfield two hundred acres of land it being part of a survey before mentioned on Cumbrian River. a part of six hundred and forty acres over the mountains.

Then I give and bequeath to my son Shadrach Barfield two hundred acres of land being of a survey before mentioned on Cumbrian River.

Then I give and bequeath to my son Frederick Barfield two hundred and forty acres of land being part of the six hundred and forty acres before mentioned on Cumbrian River.

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Emily Broad five shillings sterling.

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter India Hamell five shillings sterling

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Brown five shillings sterling. and after giving and disposing of my estate as before mentioned. I do appoint my well beloved wife and son Elias Barfield whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament.
