

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the Name of God "Amen"

I George H. Melvin of the County of Bladen and State of North Carolina, Planter and Sheriff of this date, in Said County, being fully impressed with the Shortness of time, languishing with the ills that assail our nature though in full possession of the Powers of mind with which God has blessed me, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows.

Item 1st It is my will that all my just debts be paid as speedily as the Nature of the case will admit and for this purpose desire that the tract of land lately purchased on the Cape Fear River known as the McLelland land be sold and the proceeds be applied for this purpose. And my lands also known as the Mallatt land in Sampson County, for the sum of four hundred Dollars and his five Shillings also to be sold in short terms, as my Executors may deem most advisable to enhance the value of the aforesaid property, and the proceeds as soon as realized be applied as above desired and if the aforesaid tracts of land and negroes together with such debts as may be due me do not afford sufficient means to accomplish this end, it is my desire that they sell such other property as they may deem most advisable and in sufficient amount to pay all my just debts.

I give and bequeath unto my truly beloved wife Lucy Jane the following property to wit:

Peter, Rose, and her children. Mary and her child Andrew, & Maria, & Edmund, Sam, Davis and Jacob, the plantation where I now live and improvements and all the Household Furniture all my stock of hogs and cattle and mules and my Bell home and my Buggys and harness and all my farming utensils.

It is my desire that my daughter Hannah have the farming property for her share of her portion to wit: forty and two

Julia Ann and her children. Sally, Sarah, Dick, and Frank, Alfred, also:

The old plantation which I have purchased at my factors sale and my mare "Black Kate"

Date 4th It is my will that all property not devised in the first going items be equally divided between my dear wife and my beloved daughter before named and it is further my wish that whenever my wife or my daughter die, then the property devised to them respectively shall revert to the survivor unless in the event of their leaving him of their bodies then the heirs to inherit or should they or either of them marry or die leaving husbands surviving them without children then the husbands to inherit what they leave.

I appoint and nominate my beloved wife Anna Jane and daughter Hannah Jane, Executrices of this my last Will and Testamento, to execute the same in its intentions before named.
