Item I give to my Sons Jesse, Thomas, Joseph and William Thomas the sum of Five Shillings each Lawful money of this state which is to be paid to them by my Executors

Item I further order and my mind and will is that the other two thirds of all my personal and Real estate my goods lands goods and chattels and moveable estate shall be valued by my Executors and equally divided amongst them my first born namely Thomas, Martha, John, and Samuel Thomas.

Lastly, I constitute make and ordain Martha my dearly beloved wife Executrix and also James Jackson Joseph, Thomas, and William Thomas Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament Wills Bequests and bequests Executors by me in any way before made Wills and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament

I Henry Sawrey, Senr. of North Carolina, North Hampton County, being in perfect sense and memory thanks be to God for it. I do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

First and principally I recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty God that gave it, hoping through the mediation death and passion of my only Saviour Jesus Christ to have full pardon and remission of all my sins, and my body to be decently buried by my Executors here after named.

And for such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me dispose as follows.

Item I lend to my son John Sawrey, two hundred acres of land where he now lives also five head of Cattle five head of sheep a pair of hand mill stones, one iron pot and kettle a pair of stellyardes, one basin, one dish, four plates a pair of Spoon moulds and a currying knife during his natural life and possession.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Henry Sawrey two hundred and five acres of land that I lend to my son John Sawrey after his death or out of his possession, also one brass kettle and a pair of money scales and weights and two head of cattle also each and every article that I lend to my son John Sawrey.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Melissa Sawrey one feather bed and furniture one loom, and gears one little pot, one dish, three plates and basin three head of sheep one cow and calf one spire mortar and one side saddle one looking glass one trunk one woolen wheel and a horse where John Sawrey now lives as long as she lives a single life.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Sawrey one feather bed and furniture one cow and three head of sheep one basin one dish two plates and a linen wheel and woolen wheel and little trunk.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth

Justice five shillings proc. it being all I intend for her of my estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Britt five shillings proc. it being all I intend for her of my estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Phillips five shillings proc. it being all I intend for her of my estate.

I do hereby leave my two sons Henry Sawrey and Edward Sawrey who I do constitute make and ordain my only and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament and do disallow revoke and disannull all and every other person and former Testaments and Legacies by me in any way before this time here named: Willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.

And as touching this worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of it in the following manner and form.

Item I give to my well beloved son John Wingate whom I do nominate and appoint my sole Executor of this my last will and Testament, my negro man named Peter likewise my negro woman named Phillis with all my sheep and hogs, cattle excepting three cows and calves together with all my household goods except one pewter dish and three plates and one iron pot and blue Colored and my wearing apparel to be equally divided between my son John's Wife and my daughter Mary Simmons likewise all my houses and lands being more or less to my son John Wingate and I the said Ann Wingate do hereby disallow revoke and disannull all other wills or forms or Legacies or deeds of gift in any other case given or bequeathed unto any other person or persons whatsoever ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
