Item I give grant and bequeath unto my beloved and loving Son Leonard Look. one Negro boy atty.

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved and loving Son. in Law Benjamin Ellwell. one negro boy named. Kilbury.

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved and loving Son. Isaac. one negro boy named Harry.

Item I give grant and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Eunice Look all the rest of my goods and chattels. with the land before given to Isaac Look. which she is to keep in full possession until deceased then passing them to the aforesaid Isaac Look. and whereas breeding much contention divided.

I do give grant and bequeath unto my beloved and loving daughter Susannah Look. her first living child. and the rest of her unissued any and other particulars not mentioned and the same to be equally divided among my heirs and heirsesses except the one half of a tract of land lying on the shore of Longtango Lake containing 300 acres. which I give grant and bequeath unto my beloved and loving Son Leonard Look.

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Rev the aforesaid my well beloved and loving wife Eunice Look. and my well beloved and loving Son Leonard Look to be my sole Executors and Executor of this my last will and testament.

I. Isaac Jones of Bladen County. being through the abundant mercy and goodness of God through make in body yet of sound mind and perfect understanding and memory do constitute this my last Will. and Testament and desire that it may be revocable by all as such.

First- I most humbly bequeath my soul to god my maker. beseeching his most gracious acceptance of it. through the all sufficient merits and meritiations of most compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ. who gave himself to be atonement for my sins.

I give my body to the earth from which it came in full assurance of its resurrection from thence at the last day. as for my burial I desire it may be decent at the discretion of my Executors Hereafter named. As to my worldly estate I will and positively order that all my just debts be paid and discharged.

First. I give to my Son Edward Jones. my negro Scur and Prince and my negro French old. Phillis also one child part of all my household stuff to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son in Law Benjamin Humphrey the sum of Five shillings Sterling money.

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I give to my Son in Law John Jackson two Cows and calves to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son in Law Jacob Steadon six Cows and calves to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son Isaac Jones all the Plantation of land whereon I now live with all the improvements, the Crops now on said lands, excepted, also my Saw Mill and the land belonging to it, also fifty acres of land joining Bartrams Lake also my three negroes Sam. Venus and child Sam also my mixing desk, and shot guns, also the one third part of all my household stuff, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son Musgrave Jones, my farm at Elizabethtown and all the lots I own in said town, also all the other land I am possessed of not already bequeathed, also my three negroes Bob, Jean and John, also my riding horse and saddle and my silver watch, and the one third part of my household stuff, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my grand daughter Jean Humphrey when she shall come to eighteen years of age my two negroes and her child Prudence to her and her heirs forever.

But if the said Jean Humphrey should die before she is eighteen years of age, then my will is that the said Lucy and Prudence and any children the said Lucy may have, be equally divided between my two Sons, Isaac and Musgrave Jones, their heirs and assigns forever.

I also give to my brothers Joseph Williams and Seward Saightons my two negroes Kate and Tom, also all the household stuff I had with them married by marriage also one yoke of Oxen to them, their heirs and assigns forever. They the said Saightons not to indemnify my Executors and their heirs from all debts their mother owed.

before I married her, and the remainder of my estate with the crop now on the ground after my debts are paid I give my Sons Isaac and Musgrave Jones.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint them Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

I Mary Lamb being very sick and weak in body but in perfect mind and memory thanks be to god for the same and my Soul I recommend it to god that gave it and my body I recommend it to the ground to be buried in a christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again and when with it hath pleased god to bless this world I do dispose of my worldly goods in the manner and form following viz-

First

I give my lands containing 200 acres to be sold at public sale and the money to be equally divided between Jacob Lamb and Isaac Lamb, after my decease and my cattle after my decease to be equally divided between Jacob and Isaac, only Thomas Clark is to have two Cows and Calves, and one Son and Pig, and all my Hogs and Poultry I give to the said Jacob and Isaac, to be equally divided between them.
