In the Chancery of God "Guru"
of said M^r Kay of Bladue County and Province
of North Carolina being sick and weak of body
but of sound mind memory and understanding
do make and publish this my last Will and Test-
ament in manner and form following to wit.

I will and desire that all my lawful debt, and
funeral charges be paid.

Also I will and desire that my wife Ann M^r Kay
may possess all the worldly goods I now stand
possessed of during her natural life and to be
disposed of at her decease in manner and form
following To wit

All my lands to be equally divided amongst
my four boys. Ralph, John, Christopher and
Daniel M^r Kay. Likewise all my movable
migras hogo horses, cattle and sheep to be
equally divided amongst my children. —
Isabel and Elizabeth M^r Kay. Likewise Bed and
bedding.

And I hereby nominate and appoint my
wife Ann M^r Kay and my sons Ralph
and John M^r Kay Executors and Executrix
of this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all former will and wills
by me made.

must die being of perfect mind it^e do make this
my last Will in manner and form as follows. viz—

I leave and bequeath to my Brothers Hugh and
Samuel Porter, all that I am now possessed of
at this time with what may be now due or
will hereafter become due to me they paying Evan
Ellis ten pounds for my funeral expenses and
what other trouble he may be at with one white &
one black. I also order that my negro Jupiter with
my horse and saddle be sold at publice Vnuue
giving twelve months credit and that what part of
or one half of my said estate when collected be put
to interest till my brother Sandy is of age. the other
half my Brother Hugh is to have when it may be got
together to be equally divided.

I also appoint Evan Ellis and William Mcree
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal. This 15th day of October 1773.
