## RECORD OF WILLS.

In the Name of God. "Amen"

I James M. Andrews of the County of Bladen  
and State of North Carolina being of sound mind  
and memory blessed be to Almighty God for the same  
do make publish and declare this to be my last  
Will and Testament in manner and form as follows  
to wit = on the the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February in the  
year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and  
fifty -

Item 1<sup>st</sup>  
I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Eliza  
Andrews all my lands and plantations where  
on I now live with all the improvements thereon  
belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto during  
her natural life or widowhood.

Also the following Negroes to wit - Isaac Penn Farmer  
Margaret. Hannah. Sasa. Isaac. Andrew Henry and  
Tom. all of my household and kitchen furniture  
all of my Stock of horses, cattle hogs and sheep  
farming tools of every description. one Buggy and  
Stamper one Ox Cart and wheels, one New Wagon  
nearly finished. one Room and all the gear there  
to belonging all of my Spinning wheels and carts  
all of my Corn Gossamer Shucks. Bacon Lard Cotton  
Peas. Flax. One Log Boat. and all of my Saved  
Lumber of every description. all of the Sugar Coffer  
Team and every other which is used in the  
family. in hand during her natural life or  
widowhood.

Item 2  
I give to my beloved son James Washington Andrews  
one certain tract or parcel of land known as  
the Timothy Andrews land. one negro man named  
Anthony. all of my Wood Shop tools. all of my  
Black Smith tools. to him and his heirs forever.

Item 3  
I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter  
Margaret Elizabeth Merideth one negro girl named  
Sabbina. to her and her heirs forever.

Item 4<sup>th</sup>  
I give to my beloved Catherine Jane Baumans  
one negro boy named Jack to her and her  
heirs forever.

Item 5  
I give to my beloved Miss Elizabeth Andrews

after paying off all of my just debts.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend  
John Sharp, my Executor to this my last Will and Testament.

I also give the proceeds of a certain tract of land  
known as the John Sharp land containing two hundred  
and thirty acres. which land I have bargained to sell  
and Washington Servit for the sum of six hundred dollars  
which I wish my Executor to make title to.

I give the proceeds of said land to my beloved wife  
Elizabeth Andrews.

I give to my beloved daughter Hannah Ann Andrews  
one negro boy named Isaac. which I have heretofore  
given my wife during her natural life or widowhood to  
her and her heirs forever.

I give to my daughter Eliza Kelly Andrews. one  
negro boy Andrews. which I have heretofore given my wife  
Elizabeth during her natural life or widowhood to her  
and her heirs forever.

The property that I have heretofore given my wife  
during her life or widowhood after her death to be  
equally divided among all my children.
