

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the name of God "Amen"

I James Dorsey of the County of Bladen and State of North Carolina being of disposing mind and memory. Blessed be God for His mercies, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following

1st It is my Will and desire that my Executor hereafter to be named, will see that all my just debts and funeral expenses are paid out of the effects, which I may be owed of at my death

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved Mother my Sordid Horse.

3^d I give and bequeath to my brother Robert Dorsey Five dollars -

4th I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all of my stock of Horses, Cattle Hogs and every other kind of stock, that I may die seized and possessed of.

I also give to my Wife Elizabeth Ann, all my money notes and accounts and my land that I may possess at my death together with all and everything that I may be worth except the above mentioned Horse that I gave to my Mother and five dollars that I have given above to my brother Robert, to her heirs Executors, Administrators and assigns forever.

5th It is my Will and desire that my Executor hereafter to be named, will manage my estate in the way he thinks best, which I think there is no doubt but what he will.

Lastly, I do constitute and appoint my worthy friend David Lewis, Sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I the said James Dorsey, do set my hand and seal the 11th day of January 1841

I Clatman Young being of sound mind and memory and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, and being desirous before that event shall occur, in regard to myself, to make a testamentary disposition of such worldly effects, as it hath pleased the almighty to bless me with, do therefore make the following bequests and devise of the same - viz - that is to say, in the first place -

I want my just debts to be paid - in the second place, I give and bequeath unto my brother William Young my half of the plantation where I now live, adjoining Hillis Cornetts, and Ninefolds Singletarys land, also my interest in a sixty four acre survey, on the West Side of Goodman Swamp, adjoining the lands of Thomas and Bartrams Roberson, and Hillis Cornetts land.

And in the third place, I give unto my mother Sarah Young, all my other effects - viz -

My Roan Horse, and my stock of Hogs, Cattle and every other article not before mentioned.

"Solely" I do hereby ordain and appoint my brother William Young, my Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof, I hereby set my hand and seal in presence of three witnesses, this the 19th day of January AD 1841.
