It is my wish and desire that she be not hired out until the death of my two sisters Margaret Corn. and Elizabeth McMillan. I give and bequeath after my death all my property of whatever kind to my nephews and nieces Daniel St. McMillan and Margaret Elizabeth McMillan to be equally divided between them. It is my desire and wish that this division shall not take place until after the death of my two sisters now living with me. It is my wish and desire that Daniel St. McMillan my nephew should there be any children from Patsy receive one or two. It is my desire that the Rev. William Brokston be Executor and my executors be my Executrix. And now I humbly commend myself soul and body into the hands of a merciful and God in Christ Jesus my Lord humbly praying that he may save me with an everlasting salvation in Heaven.
