And concerning the division of my negroes and their increase and all the other movable effects belonging to me mind and will is that all shall be equally divided amongst all my children both boys and girls after the death of marriage of my dear wife Rebekah Lock. And the negroes that fall to each of my daughters. I give and bequeath to each of them and their heirs forever, further my will and desire is if it should please God to take any of them my children out of this world before they should have nine lambs or four of the females or lawfully begotten by the time that their portion or legacy shall be equally divided amongst the rest of my children that shall be alive.

I likewise constitute make and ordain my dear and well beloved wife Elizabeth and Benjamin Cooper. Executrix and Benjamin Cooper. Executor of this my last will and Testament. And I do hereby disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament will & legacy or bequest and Executors by one in any way before wills named or bequeathed. ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

Bladen County I John Lock of the County and Province aforesaid
Slater. being now make of body but of perfect mind and
memory. thanks be given unto God almighty to send the nob-
tality of my body and reasoning that it is appointed
for all men once to die do make and ordain this my
last will and testament. That is to say principally and
first of all.

I give and recommend my soul to god that gave
it and my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion
of my Executors. nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God. and as touching such worldly
estate wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me
in this life. I give devise and dispose of the same
in the following manner and form
First of all I give and bequeath unto my well
beloved wife Elizabeth my dwelling house and
slavery wherein I now live during the time of
her widowhood and afterwards to be equally de-
vided between my two sons Joseph and Leonard
Lock and likewise a piece of back land be-
longing to Stevens land. And further I give to my
beloved son Thomas one half of a piece of
land lying between Hickson Creek and Stevens
Creek. joining his own lightwood land. and the other
half I give to my sons to be equally divided and
likewise I give to my son Thomas one pair steigants the
height 152. and likewise I give to my son John
part of a Cedar Swamp, lying on Stevens Creek
Swamp. patented in my own name and Benjamin Lock
the half of said land and likewise my will is to
give my daughter Elizabeth one cow and a
calf. likewise as soon as it can conveniently be done
they are to purchase a likely negro girl. likewise I
give to my daughter Hannah one cow and calf
likewise in proper time at the discretion of my Exec-
utors to the rest of my daughters. Mary Eliza Anna
and Rebekah. each one cow and calf. my desire

is furthered that each of my daughters Namely
Mary Elizabeth Suseau their Elizabath. That
each of them shall have a negro if they can
be conveniently got, either by purchase or purchase
and Perchance the said tools and the steel is for
the use of all my Sons Thomas John Joseph and
Leonard but is to be kept here on the place
where I now live which is to be the property of
my son Leonard, likewise one hundred and one
hundred liquors on Black River to be equal between
my two Sons Joseph and Edward and the stock
that is there to be for the use of the family.
Further I give to my Son Leonard one negro boy
named Sam One Rullo Gun One Bushel, the rest of
the Negroes to be kept together for the support of
the family further the cattle on the place is to
be kept together for the use of the family, and one
Musket Gun. Further my will is that the sum of
the Negro girls I give to my daughter Elizabeth
shall be given to her three children Sarah
dannah and Elizabeth, but first of all to pay all
all debts. And lawful demands shall be satisfied
and paid by the Executors whom I shall
now appoint.

And I do hereby constitute and ordain my
sons Thomas Lock and John Lock to be my
whole and sole Executors of this my last Will
and Testament, revoking all other Wills and
Testaments by me made, and do declare this to
be my last Will and Testament and no other for
entitled whereto I have reserved to set my hand
and seal this the 8th day of October in the
Year of Our Lord 1789.

The last will and Testament
of Robert McRee, who being of perfect and sound
Memory but infirm in body, and the time of my
death drawing near in the first place I give my
soul to my god who gave it, in due hope of a joyful
resurrection of my body at the last day and my body
to be decently buried and what it shall please
God to bless me with of this worlds goods. I do dispose
of them in the following manner viz

If it shall please God that my beloved wife Jane
should Juniper me, I desire that nothing of what this
world I leave behind me shall be taken from her
during her life but that she may have a comfortable
living out of the same, and after her decease to be
divided in the following manner. All my lands my
Negro Dick, Cattle Horses and stock of every kind
Furniture Working tools and anything that I do possess
be valued and whatever it is valued at to be divided
into six parts and each of my children to have their
equal part. My Son William part I desire that my
Grand Son Robert McRee do draw his part only ten pounds
out of my Grand Son Robert McRee Son to William
McRee be given to my Grand daughter Helen McRee
and my daughter Elizabeth part I desire that her son
John May be schooled out of it my daughter Sarah
Christian part to be equally divided between her
