

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the Name of God "Amen"

I John Andrews being in a low State of Health
but being of sound Mind and Memory, Blessed be
God for the same, do thinks proper to publish and
make this my last will and testament, in the
following manner to wit,

1st I give and grant all of my lands to my
sons William H. and Patrick J. They shall begin a
dividing line at my upper corner on the River ad-
joining Pridges. Thence with Pridges line to
my back line then with said line to the Mill road
thence with said road to the Mill dam. Thence up
the east edge of the Mill Pond. Two chains. William
to have all of my lands lying to the above desig-
nated lines. And last of Mill Pond.

And Patrick to have all my lands lying South
of the above lines. Also he (Patrick) to have all my
lands lying on the West side of Lake Creek. also he
to have all my lands lying in Chatham County on
South River.

I give to my daughter Ann C. my girl Maria,
I give to my son William my man Jack,
I give to my daughter Sarah J. a boy James
I give to my Elizabeth. One and half
I give to my daughter Mary A. girl Lydia
I give to my son Patrick a girl Nancy also
I give him one Black Mare also one Bid and four
nights.

All the balance of my Household Furniture to be
equally divided between my heirs.

I give to my son Patrick two hundred bushels
of Corn.

Also I give him two thousand pounds of Bacon
also I give him one set of Blacksmith Tools.
and Six Head of Cattle. The balance of my
stock of Cattle to be equally divided between
my heirs.

I give to my two sons William and Patrick
my Carriage

Also to my son Patrick one half of my farm

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divided between my heirs.

Head of Sheep.

I give to my grand daughter Sarah A. Johnson, one Black -
I do hereby ordain nominate and appoint my two
