

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the Name of God "Amen"

I John Andrews being in a low state of health but being of sound mind and memory, Blessed be God for the same, do shew proper to publish and make this my last will and testament, in the following manner to wit,

I give and grant all of my lands to my sons William H. and Patrick S. They shall begin a dividing line at my upper corner on the River ad-joining Bridgus. Thence with Bridgus line to my back line thence with said line to the mill road thence with said road to the mill dam, thence up the east edge of the mill pond, two chains, William to have all of my lands north of the above dividing line, and east of mill pond, and Patrick to have all my lands lying south of the above line, also he, Patrick, to have all my lands lying on the west side of Lake Creek, also he to have all my lands lying in Chowan County on Smith River.

I give to my daughter, Ann, C. my girl Maria,

I give to my son William my man Jack,

I give to my daughter Hannah, J. a boy Lurie

I give to my Elizabeth, Tom and Bek-

I give to my daughter Mary, a girl, Lijete

I give to my son Patrick a girl Abancy also

I give him one Black Mare also one Red and for nitars.

All the balance of my Household Furniture to be equally divided between my heirs.

I give to my son Patrick two hundred bushels of corn,

Also I give him two thousand pounds of Bacon also I give him one set of Black Smith Tools, and a Red of Cattle the balance of my stock of Cattle to be equally divided between my heirs.

I give to my two sons William and Patrick

my Carriage

and to my son Patrick one half of my farm

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divided between my heirs.

I give to my grand daughter Mary C. Johnson, one head of Sheep,

I give to my grand daughter Sarah A. Johnson, one black - I do hereby declare to intimate and appoint my two sons William H. Andrews and Patrick S. Andrews, Executors to this my last will and testament.
