

7th I give and bequeath unto my grand children
Nansom, S. Catherine, Jane and Elizabeth Murphy
two negroes named as follows. Frank and Eliza
to them and their heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Murphy
and my nephew Patrick Murphy during the
life of my son Patrick Murphy in trust for the
use and benefit of my son Patrick the C. 4.

Belongs lying in the fork of Big and Little Cotty
beginning at a pine in the Waddle and Gibson line
marked T.M. and running the course to a pine
marked P.M. to George Thomas line. Beginning again
at a pine H.M. and running thence with the
Waddle line to a pine Waddells corner near Big
Cotty, which lands includes other lands besides
that which belonged to C. A. Belongs and also
one other tract of land containing two hundred
and ninety acres. beginning at a Bay in the
edge of Cotten the north side and a pine and
oak tree in Watters Gibsons line and runs as the
grant will show. And the following negroes Dick
and at the death of my wife Catherine Tom
and after the death of my said son. Patrick I give
and bequeath the land and negroes to my
grand son. Hugh and to such other son of my
son. Patrick as may be living at his death.

8th I give and bequeath unto my grand son Hugh
Murphy a negro boy named "Rid"

9th I give and bequeath unto my two grandsons
Hugh Murphy and John Murphy two hundred
acres of land in the fork of Big and Little
Cotton.

10th I give and bequeath unto my son Arch^d
Murphy one hundred and thirty five acres of
land in Little Cotty. it being one half of a two hun-
dred and fifty acre tract. granted Patrick Murphy
and lying in the fork of. Stumps Swamp and
Little Cotty. Beginning at a pine in Rock & Ployds
line. and runs as the grant will show.

I give and bequeath unto to my two grand sons
Hugh and John Arch^d Murphy one negro girl

11th named Caroline. to them and their heirs forever.
I give and bequeath to my son Patrick Murphy
at the death of my wife Catherine Murphy one
negro named Santee.

I give and bequeath to my four daughters. viz
Margaret. Hensley. Mary Jane and Janeett all my house
hold and Kitchen furniture after the death of my
wife to be equally divided between them share and share
alike.

13th My Executors hereafter named. will and I do hereby
authorize them to sell all the unbenevoluted property
namely my Tennessee lands and Morgan and Bare
and all and every thing that belonged to me and pay
all my just debts and the residue if any to be equally
divided among all my heirs share and share alike.
In witness whereunto I have set my hand and seal
the 16th day of March 1835.

In the name of God Amen
I John Beard of the County of Bladen and State
of North Carolina being very sick and weak of
body but of sound and perfect memory and mind
do dispose of my estate in the following manner
viz I wish all my lands to be sold
by my Executors, either at private or public sale
as he may think proper except the tract in
which I now live. if the proceeds of the above
mentioned lands should not be sufficient to pay
all my debts. I wish a small part of the tract
in which I now live to be sold also.

Manely. to begin at the lower Corner of said tract and run thirty chains Northward with the meanderings of the Cape Fear River. thence one hundred and thirty chains. parallel with the present lower line thence South Treaty chains to said lower line but if the proceeds of the first mentioned lands should be sufficient to pay my debts. I do not wish the last piece of land sold.

I also wish my Timber Tragon four mules and all the necessary gear to be sold. the residue of my property I wish to be kept together in the plantation under the management of my dear wife and to be equally divided among our children at the expiration of four years. I do not wish any of the negroes to be sold. I wish all the children to be kept at school. as much as possible I also wish my dear wife to render any assistance to my dear wife that she may need from time to time

I hereby constitute and appoint my friend John Stokes Parson. my lawful Executor of this my last will and Testament

In Witness whereof in presence of three witnesses I hereby set my hand and seal this the 6th day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five.

I James Kelly one of the County of Bladen State of North Carolina being of sound and disposing mind and memory blessed be almighty god. do this the second day of June in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following - that is to say -

I give and devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary For and during her natural life the following property. viz

The tract of the house farm with the privilege of the Mausum house and all the out houses. one more saddle and bridle one Cart, the furnish of my Cart and Shop the furnish of the plantation tools and two negroes one man and one woman. My man Joe and the woman at her own option and forty head of hogs with a Childs part of the Household and Kitchen furniture the aforesaid property to be equally divided between the heirs after her death. with the exception of her part of the lands and plantation tools which is to go to the Male heirs.

I then

I give devise and bequeath to my sons Archibald Kelly, David, and Duncan Kelly. three hundred and eighty acres of land to be equally divided between them my son James. C. Kelly. got his part of the lands previous to this time. after the debt is paid. and my three sons three David and Duncan Kelly has got some more schooling and Duncan comes of age my will is that the balance of the property be equally divided between all the heirs Male and Female.

I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my sons Archibald Kelly and James. C. Kelly. Executors to this my last will and Testament hereby making all others by me made and declaring this and one other to be my last will and Testament
