I do give and bequeath my estate as follows -
 I give unto William Singletary Cunningham
 born of the body of Rachel Cunningham one

 also two negroes named as follows. Chiptune and
 Jajah.

This is to certify that William Smith born
 John Pemberton and Samuel Smith personally
 appeared before me Ephraim Muford Justice of the
 Peace. That the above writing was made the 31st
 day of May 1791 in the lifetime of the said Richard
 Singletary and that to the best of their knowledge and
 belief he the said Singletary was in his proper
 senses at the time and that the said Singletary
 expired before the above will could be finished
 and purified their depositions except not
 sworn to before me the 1st day of June 1791.

 once to die do make and obtain this my last will
 and Testament that is to say Principally and first
 of all.

It is my will and desire that all my just debts
 be paid and satisfied

It is my will and desire that Joanna my

wife ~~shamp~~ Rase one plantation on Bogus during
 her life or Widenhook now in possession of Thomas
 Runy and all my horse hold goods and furniture
 and one horse bridle and saddle and also to have
 fifteen head of good Hogs.

Item I also give and bequeath to Joanna my wife
 one third of my cattle and the remainder to be
 equally divided between my six children

Item It is my desire that all my lands and negroes
 should be equally divided between my six children
 when the eldest comes of age also I desire that all
 the remainder of my Hogs to be sold and two
 horses also

I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Joanna
 Smith Executrix and my Brother John Smith
 and Richard Reynolds Executors.

In the first place I order that all my Just debts shall all be paid out of my estate. And secondly I give and bequeath to Martha my dearly beloved wife, one third part of all my remaining estate during the time of her life, then to be given to the children at her disposal.

Item I give to my sons Jesse, Thomas, Joseph and William Thomas the sum of Five Shillings each Lawful money of this State which is to be paid to them by my Executors.

Item I further order and my mind and will is that the other two thirds of all my personal and Real estate negroes lands goods and chattels and moveable estate shall be valued by my Executors and equally divided amongst them my four children namely - Thomas, Martha, John, and - Samuel Thomas.

Lastly, I constitute make and ordain Martha my dearly beloved wife Executrix and also James Jackson Joseph, Thomas, and William Thomas Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament Wills Bequests and bequests Executors by me in any way before made Will and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the name of God Amen.

I Henry Sawrey Senr. of North Carolina, North Hampton County being in perfect sense and memory thanks be to God for it. I do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

First and principally I recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty God that gave it, hoping through the mediation death and passion of my only Saviour Jesus Christ to have full pardon and remission of all my sins, and my body to be decently buried by my Executors hereafter named.

And for such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me dispose as follows.

Item I bequeath to my son John Sawrey two hundred acres of land where he now lives also five head of Cattle five head of sheep a pair of hand mill stones, one iron pot and kettle a pair of stellyardes, one basin, one dish, four plates a pair of Spoon moulds and a currying knife during his natural life and possession.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Henry Sawrey two hundred and five acres of land that I bequeath to my son John Sawrey after his death or out of his possession, also one brass kettle and a pair of money scales and weights and two head of Cattle also each and every article that I bequeath to my son John Sawrey.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter William Sawrey one feather bed and furniture one loom, and gears one little pot, one dish, three plates and basin three head of sheep one cow and calf one spice mortar and one side saddle one looking glass one trunk one woolen wheel and a horse where John Sawrey now lives as long as she lives a single life.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Sawrey one feather bed and furniture one cow and three head of sheep one basin, one dish, two plates and a linen wheel and woolen wheel and little trunk.
