This is the 29th day of December in the year of
Our Lord one Thousand One hundred and
Ninety Eight. I Joseph Cain of Robeson
County State of North Carolina Planter being
in perfect mind and memory and under
Standing Chanks be to god therfor Intend
ering now the uncertainty of human life
and knowing it is allotted for all men to die
do make this my last Will and Testament in
manner following that is to say.

As to what worldly estate it hath pleased god
to bless me with in this world I give devise
and bequeath in the following manner and
form namely.

First of all I give unto my Raif Broket John
Cain Ten Shillings Sterling to him and his
heirs forever.

I give unto my Raif Broket James Cain the
sum of Ten Shillings Sterling to him and his heirs
forever.

I give and bequeath unto my nephews Joseph
Cain the son of Samuel Cain the sum of
Ten Shillings Sterling

I give and bequeath unto George Willis Cain
of Robeson County the sum of Ten Shillings Sterling
to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto Anne Robison
the wife of Jonathan Robison and daughter
of Samuel and Susan Ann Cain the sum of

and fifty acres of land where I now live and five
hundred acres joining the upper side and joining
the lower side of Thomas Lewis' land during his
natural life at his death the land is to descend
to her son Samuel Robison with all orchards
and houses thereon.

I give unto the said Anne Robison two clocks
one in the Room and one West. Two equipage all the
tools in the Room and feather bed and furniture
I give unto the said Anne Robison two negro men
and her child Billie.

At the death of the said Anne Robison I desire
that the furniture and negroes with their incomes
may be divided among her children equally.

I give and bequeath unto Mary Stedman of
Fayetteville N.C. One feather bed and Furniture
and Furniture,

I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Beck
wife of Benjamin Beck one feather bed and furniture
These ends the will in the original Book.
