This sixth day of October 1772. I Josiah Wilson of Bladen County and Province of North Carolina being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die. do make this my last Will and Testament. First and principally I commend my soul to God that gave it. my ^{body} I commend to the care to be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named. as to my temporal estate I bequest and dispose of it in the following manner.

My Will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid and discharged as soon as possible after my decease.

I give to my Son George Wilson a piece or part of a Survey of land containing three hundred and twenty acres of land being the one half of

his hundred and forty acres granted and patented to Capt. George Mathew as by the said Patent may more fully and at large appear, to him the said George Wilson his heirs and assigns forever.

I also give grant and bequeath to my Son Ambrose Wilson three hundred and twenty acres of land between the above said land and Dr. Thomas Stalls land being granted and patented to John Davis Esq. as by the said Patent may more fully and at large appear to him the said Ambrose Wilson his heirs and assigns forever.

I also give unto my Son John Wilson a negro boy named Sam unto him the said John Wilson his heirs and assigns forever. And my Will further is that if either of the above said sons should depart this life before the age of twenty one years that his part be divided between the other two.

My Will is that the remaining part of my estate consisting of one negro man and one negro woman horses cattle household furniture and articles whatsoever of my said Estate be divided between my beloved wife and our five daughters viz Sarah, Deborah, Mary Ann, and Elizabeth to them and their heirs forever, which said division to be when my Executors shall find it necessary.

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint William Satter and John Satter to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament And I do declare this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.
