State of North Carolina Bladen County July 27th 1887

Smith and his mother also, I give a yearling to William Lewis Boswell by the name of Pet and the increase to him and his sisters and also I give my river place to my 7 daughters to be sold and the money divided equally between the girls. I have let 3 boys have my Colly land and I want Thomas & Susan Smith to take out what belongs to them of the house and kitchen furniture and I want the balance of the cattle and sheep and bees and household & kitchen furniture and farming implement to be sold and the money to be divided between all my children. My desire is that all my children will be satisfied with this will now I leave my son Cass to be executor to this will and to have the full management of it.
