

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the Name of God Amen

I Margaret McDugald of the County of Bladen
and State of North Carolina, being in sound heart
of body and mind according to my age, do make and
publish this my last will and testament, in manner
and form as follows:

I give and bequeath to my several children and
their children after them, the following named property
in such portions and proportions as I here set forth and
specified with all the increase if any since especially
the Negro slaves. Namely =

Tom a Slave aged fifty or more. Peter aged fifty
five or there abouts. John Thirty five or there abouts the
said Peter and John I have already given in advance to
my son Paul McDugald, deceased, widow and Peter, my
daughter Delila Ann McMillan, and children Sophie
and one child Edward, and Jane and one child named
Stephen, together with all my forming utensils and plant
ation tools. Stones Rock and Kickie, furniture all of my stock
of Cattle Rogo, and Horse and Rockaway, and horses with
whatever of prop. I may have growing at present, to
gether with all valuable bonds notes or accounts or bills
due me Cast in Hand, if any at my decease, free and
clear of all claims or encumbrances whatsoever.

First Chew. I give a lot and bequeath that my grand
children, the Children of my son Paul McDugald, share
and have alike in the portion I give them.

John a Slave which I have deeded them aeroing to take
effect at my decease, to go to with all money that I have
from time to time advanced to my son Paul, while living
with all notes account, which I had or had against
him or them at my death. This includes all that I
extant for them except such as I may mention herein
after.

2^d I give to my son James, D. McDugald my trustee hereby
nominating and appointing him, with all necessary power to act
as over the following named portion of my whole estate
in special trust and confidence that he will hold and pos-
sess the same for the sole and separate use benefit and
behalf of my grand children severally and their heirs and
issue my trustees death, to rest in them absolutely.

Namely, the one fifth of all my property with the money and
particularly that of the negro slaves.

3^d I give to my son wife McDugald my trustee hereby name-
inating and appointing him with all necessary power to act
as such. The following named portion of my whole estate in
special trust and confidence that he will hold and pos-
sess the same for the sole and separate use benefit and
behalf of my daughter Emily McAllister during her life
time and at her death to rest absolutely, all or such balanc-
e thereof as may be left by her in my grand children the chil-
dren of our slave Namely, William J., John L. and Emily J.
McDugald, one hundred dollars each the residue if any
to my grand children. The children of my daughter Delila Ann
McMillan, Namely, Mary Ann, John Ann, Margaret Ann and
Sarah, H. McMillan share and share alike, and to rest
in them absolutely and their heirs one fifth of my estate
at my decease.

4^d I give to my son wife McDugald my trustee hereby
nominating and appointing him with all necessary power to
act as such the following named portion of my whole estate
in special trust and confidence that he will hold and pos-
sess the same for the sole and separate use benefit
and behlf of my grand children severally and their
heirs and at his my trustees death to rest in them absolute-
ly namely, the one fifth of all my property with the
increase particularly of the negro slaves and one family
clock,

5^d I give to my friend William A. Savage my trustee hereby
nominating and appointing him with all necessary power to act as such
the following property in special trust and confidence that
he will hold and possess the same for the sole and separate
use and benefit and behlf of my daughter Delila Ann
McMillan, and at his my trustees death to rest in her and
her children absolutely Namely - A negro man slave Peter
which they now hold under me by advancement and con-
tract together with all money, note bonds accounts and
claims, upon them by me that their portion I give by advance-
ment.

I give to my son wife McDugald my trustee hereby
nominating and appointing him with all necessary power
to act as such, the following named portion of my property
in special trust and confidence that he will hold and pos-

passes the same for the sole use and benefit and
behoof of my daughter Eliza Ann McDugald. Four hun-
dred dollars to be given her at her discretion in case she
she may need in her life time. The prospect of having
children being hopeless I make the provision that should
she die without child, issue then and in that case
all that I have set apart for her separate use to my
trustee at her death or the death of Noel my trustee
all of said Eliza's portion or any balance to rest equally
between James D. and Eliza McDugald children surviving and
absolutely.

7th. I give to my son Steve McDugald my trustee fully
nominating and appointing him with all necessary power
to act as and the following named property or portion of
my estate in special trust and confidence that in
will hold and possess the same for the sole use lawful
and behoof of my grand children. The children of my
daughter Margaret King deceased, namely -
Martha, Mrs. Margaret, R. Michael and William Archibald
King. The one fifth of my property or an amount
equal with that proportion in money as I do not
exist the slaves or this moreover to be removed out of
the state and at the death of my trustee to rest in them
or their heirs absolutely.

8th. Here let me say that I positively will that the income
of my slaves property if any yet exist the original
and shall be held with and under the intention of this
will. S.C. to rest in like manner and form as above set forth

9th. I give to my grand daughter Mary Ann McMillan
my Beauford and one Bed and furniture

10th. I give to my grand daughter Margaret Ann McDugald
one Cow and Calf.

11th. I give to my grand daughter Margaret G. McDugald
one Bed and furniture and one Mahogany Table.

12th. I give to my grand daughter Margaret Elinor McDugald
one Looking glass.

13th. I give to my grand son Sugard McDugald one large
Gauzy Chest.

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
James D. and Steve McDugald my only two surviving
sons my executors and trustees to this my last will

and testament with full power as such to have executed and
caused out my intentions as herein set forth.
