I Margaret Sutton Widow of John Sutton being of  
 sound mind and memory thanks be to god do this day  
 publish and ordain this my last Will and Testament  
 in manner and form following - viz

I give and bequeath to Catherine Ann Sutton and  
 the heirs of her body, the illegitimate of my grand  
 daughter Jane Sutton two negroes coat and Stove  
 and packed bed and furniture.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter  
 Sarah Ann Melvin four cows and calves, one bedstead  
 feather bed and furniture half a dozen cups and  
 saucers, half a dozen of plates, one dish two chairs  
 one table, one large iron pot one tea kettle Trestle stool  
 and hogs.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter  
 Elizabeth Melvin four pewter plates one dish one brass  
 candle stick, one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to my grand son John Sutton  
 one two year old heifer.

I give and bequeath to Eliza Russ one cow and calf  
 one of.

I give and bequeath to Patrick Kelly one yoke of oxen.

I give to my daughter Ann Sutton four negroes Anna  
 Archibald, Moll and Daniel during her natural life  
 and after her decease to be equally divided among  
 the surviving heirs of her body should Catherine Ann Sutton  
 the illegitimate child of my grand daughter Jane  
 Sutton die without issue, I give and bequeath that  
 part bequeathed to her, to my daughter Ann Sutton  
 and the surviving heirs of her body.

Should Sarah Ann Melvin die leaving no issue I  
 give and bequeath all that part bequeathed to her, to  
 my grand daughter Sarah Jane Sutton after my  
 lawful debts are paid out of the unbequeathed  
 part of my estate all that may remain I give to  
 my daughter Ann Sutton

And I do hereby appoint my friends James  
 Seromantis and David Lloyd Executors to this my  
 last Will and Testament.

The Manumission Will of George Lemmon.  
 He desires that two horse creatures viz-  
 The fole mare and stells colt be sold to educate  
 his children and that the family keep the residue  
 for their use and that the black people remain  
 on the plantation if they continue to be orderly, if  
 otherwise to be hired out.

Jamieson McGinnis Will:-

Whenever it shall please God to call me from this  
 transitory existence to an eternal state I desire that  
 my executors hereafter named should in the first place  
 punctually pay my just debts out of what worldly estate  
 I may possess at the time of my dissolution after which  
 it is my will and desire that my beloved wife should  
 she out live me viz: Ann McGinnis shall have the one  
 third part of all my property that is perishable for her  
 own and independent use forever.

It is also my desire that my beloved wife Ann  
 McGinnis shall have the one third part of my real  
 estate attached to some commodious dwelling of  
 her own choice and that to be solely vested in her  
 during her natural life.

I also will and desire that my dear daughter  
 Catherine Ann McGinnis shall have the remaining  
 two thirds of all my personal estate and to her and  
 the heirs of her body forever subject however to the  
 following conditions that is Should her said share  
 of my personal estate exceed two thousand dollars  
 then it is my will and desire that my Executors  
 shall give unto my sister Catherine McGinnis the  
 sum of two hundred dollars and unto my sister  
 Christian McGinnis the sum of two hundred dollars  
 or the value thereof to each of my said sisters which  
 respective sums shall be and vest in them and  
 their heirs forever.

Should my said daughters shares of my personal  
 estate not exceed two thousand dollars then I do  
 desire that each of my said sisters shall have one  
 hundred dollars each out of my said estate to  
 vest in them and their heirs forever.

It is also my desire that my said daughter  
 Catherine Ann McGinnis shall have the remaining  
 two thirds of my real estate to be and absolutely  
 vest in her and her heirs forever.

It is also my will and desire that the third part  
 of my real estate heretofore bequeathed to my beloved  
 wife during her natural life shall at her  
 death descend solely and absolutely to my said  
 beloved daughter Catherine Ann McGinnis to vest  
 in her and her heirs forever. but should my said  
 daughter Catherine Ann McGinnis die before she  
 arrives to a mature age and without lawful  
 issue of her body to inherit after her, it is my will  
 and desire that all her said property real and  
 personal shall go to my sister Catherine McGinnis  
 and Christian McGinnis and to my brother James  
 McGinnis to be equally divided among them share  
 and share alike to them and their heirs forever.

It is also my desire that my beloved wife  
 purely keep from damage my two large felt hat  
 ting glasses as also my clock and Ramsay's Memo-  
 rial History for the use of my beloved daughter  
 Catherine Ann McGinnis to be given to her when
