

In the Name of God "Amen"

I Mary Green of Brunswick County in the State of North Carolina being of sound mind and Judgment do make this my last will and Testament.

First

I give and bequeath unto my brother James Green 250 acres of land near Rockfish in Bladen County, bounded as will appear from its plot and grant also my share of my father's Plantation on the White Marsh after the death of Mrs. Green Poore.

I do also lend unto my said brother James Green Eighteen of his maternal life, four negroes, named Larry, Monimia, Joe and Clarinda, at the same time binding him not to sell or cause to be sold them or any or either one of them out of the said State of North Carolina or any of the increase of the above mentioned negroes.

It is my last desire that at my Brother James Green's death, the said negro man named Larry should have his freedom, the said three negroes named Monimia, Joe and Clarinda with their increase at my said brother's death. I give and bequeath to my niece Sarah Turner and the heirs of her body forever.

I do give and bequeath to my Brother James Green my young man to him and his heirs forever.

Secondly

I give and bequeath to my said niece Sarah Turner after James Green my brother's death, the three above negroes mentioned, Monimia, Joe & Clarinda and their increase also I give and bequeath to the said Sarah Turner my niece Fifty pounds sterling left in the hands of Mr.

John Cogdell of Georgetown S.C. for the purpose of purchasing a negro man of Mr. John Cogdell of said town and state should have bought the said negro man. the said negro should be delivered her in lieu of the Fifty pounds sterling as also the choice of my horse with my own saddle and bridle to her and the heirs of her body forever. and provided the said Sarah Turner shall die before the said James Green give and bequeath the

property herein mentioned and willed to my Nephew Thomas Turner, to him and his heirs forever.

Thirdly

I give and bequeath to my Nephew Thomas Turner the whole of my stock of cattle now in Mrs. Anne Turner's possession one cow and calf except which I give to my man servant Larry, his heirs and assigns forever.

Fourthly

I give and bequeath to Mrs. Grace Peltz Fifty pounds sterling.

Fifthly

I give and bequeath to Mrs. Sarah Smith my riding man and saddle.

Sixthly

I give and bequeath to Mr. Jane Smith and her sister five pounds sterling each.

Seventhly

I give and bequeath to Mary Green Lewis's daughter, formerly of North Carolina, now in the possession of Josiah Lewis, to be executed within six months after my death, in the purchase of a negro to be her and the heirs of her body forever.

Eighthly

I give and bequeath unto my sister Ann Thomas my riding horse "Glossy Not."

And lastly all the remaining part of my estate whether money debts negroes or any thing or things to me belonging my wearing apparel excepted to be divided share and share alike, between my sisters Anne Turner and Thomas and Sarah my Nephew and niece.

And I do hereby appoint constitute and ordain my friend Mr. John Jones of Brunswick County North Carolina to be my lawful Executor of this my last will and Testament, revoking and disannulling all other wills by me made and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 26th day of July in the Year of Our Lord 1792.

Soul to get my Maker beseeching his most
gracious acceptance of the same through the
all sufficient merit and mediations of my most
Compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ who gave
himself to be an atonement for my sins and is
able to save to the uttermost all that come unto
God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make
intercessions for them and who I trust will not
reject me a returning penitent sinner, when I
come to him for mercy in this hope and confidence
I render up my soul with comfort humbly beseeching
the most glorious and blessed Trinity one God most
Holy most merciful and gracious to prepare me for the
time dissolution and then to take me to himself
into that Peace and rest and incomparable felicity
which he has prepared for all that love and
fear him. Blessed be God.

Impressed. I give my body to the earth from whence

it was taken in full assurance of its resurrection from
thence at the last day. as for my burial I desire it may
be decent without pomp or state at the discretion of
my dear wife and my Executors hereafter named who
I doubt not will manage it with all requisite solemnity
as to worldly estate I will and order that all my just
debts be paid.

Then, I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving
wife the negro girl named Rachel to her and to her
heirs and assigns forever.

Then I also give and bequeath unto my dear and
loving wife a negro man named Dick or at least the
time which the said negro has to serve me as wife appear
by and in a bond which I have the said negro's time
to her and her heirs, and assigns forever.

Then I give and bequeath the sum of two pounds for the
use of repairing of the burying ground where I man
live the said money to be paid by my Executors when
called for by whosoever performs the work or at least
by the order of the Grave Yards.

Lastly, I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving
wife all the remainder part of my estate whether
Real or personal and I do hereby constitute and
appoint my dear and loving wife also Jonathan Ambler
and Jacob Lewis Senr to be my true and lawful Executors
and Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I
do hereby revoke and disannul all other Wills by me
made claiming and ratifying this and none but this to
be my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this the 28th day of October Anno Domini 1786
Signed sealed acknowledged ratified and confirmed by the
said John Jessip to be his last Will and Testament.
