I give to my Son in Law John Jackson two Cows and calves to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son in Law Jacob Steadon six Cows and calves to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son Isaac Jones all the Plantation of land whereon I now live with all the improvements, the Crops now on said lands, excepted, also my Saw Mill and the land belonging to it, also fifty acres of land joining Bartrams Lake also my three negroes Sam. Venus and child Sam also my mixing desk, and shot guns, also the one third part of all my household stuff, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my Son Musgrave Jones, my farm at Elizabethtown and all the lots I own in said town, also all the other land I am possessed of not already bequeathed, also my three negroes Bob, Jean and John, also my riding horse and saddle and my silver watch, and the one third part of my household stuff, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my grand daughter Jean Humphrey when she shall come to eighteen years of age my two negroes and her child Prudence to her and her heirs forever.

But if the said Jean Humphrey should die before she is eighteen years of age, then my will is that the said Lucy and Prudence and any children the said Lucy may have, be equally divided between my two Sons, Isaac and Musgrave Jones, their heirs and assigns forever.

I also give to my brothers Joseph Williams and Seward Saightons my two negroes Kate and Tom, also all the household stuff I had with them married by marriage also one yoke of Oxen to them, their heirs and assigns forever. They the said Saightons not to indemnify my Executors and their heirs from all debts their mother owed.

before I married her, and the remainder of my estate with the crop now on the ground after my debts are paid I give my Sons Isaac and Musgrave Jones.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint them Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

I Mary Lamb being very sick and weak in body but in perfect mind and memory thanks be to god for the same and my Soul I recommend it to god that gave it and my body I recommend it to the ground to be buried in a christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again and whenwith it hath pleased god to bless this world I do dispose of my worldly goods in the manner and form following viz-

First

I give my lands containing 200 acres to be sold at public sale and the money to be equally divided between Jacob Lamb and Isaac Lamb, after my decease and my cattle after my decease to be equally divided between Jacob and Isaac, only Thomas Clark is to have two Cows and Calves, and one Son and Pig, and all my Hogs and Poultry I give to the said Jacob and Isaac, to be equally divided between them.

I give them all my household goods only 100 acres of land that Hardy human live upon if he pay for it in the space of three years. From the time of his death then he is to have the same and if not is to be sold to public sale and the money to be equally divided between Jacob Lamb and Isaac Lamb.

I give to Joshua Lamb one shilling Sterling

I give to Mary Skiper one shilling Sterling

I give to Thomas Lamb one shilling Sterling

I give to Absalom Lamb one shilling Sterling

I give to Rachel Davis one shilling Sterling

I give to Patience Cartit one shilling Sterling

Lastly I do appoint Jacob and Isaac Lamb

my sole Executors after my decease,

I, Lem Glass of the State of North Carolina and County of Bladen, Stated being in perfect recollection of body and of perfect mind and memory. Thanks be given unto Almighty God. Having unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all. I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God. That gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors. Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall

receive the same again, by the mighty power of God. and as touching such worldly estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form

I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Mary Glass, all and singular the messuage tenement when I now live containing 300 acres. and to remain without interruption during her widowhood and no longer.

I give to my son Solomon Glass, one shilling Sterling to be paid him out of my estate and no more.

I give to my son Winston Glass, my plantation called Rubber Bridge and three other surveys contiguous to the same my negro boy, called to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my daughter Mary Glass my negro man Susan, and all my stock of sheep in Browning Creek in the Care of Lewis Hall.

I give to my son Lory Glass, 150 acres of land on Craven tract and 150 on Juniper Swamp my still fire arms and value and six cows to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my son Thomas Glass my dwelling house and plantation where I now live containing 300 acres of land after observing as above mentioned reserve for my wife share to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my daughter Rina Glass, fifteen cows and value and two pigs. to her heirs and assigns forever.

I give to my daughter Rocky Glass, my tract Rose to her and her heirs, and assigns forever.

I also order that all and singular the remaining part of my estate be equally divided between my children, Winston Mary Thomas Lory Rina and Rocky.

I likewise constitute and ordain my wife Mary Glass and David Singleton White Executors and Executor of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly disavow and revoke and disannul all and every other Testament will Legacies Executors and bequests by me in any wise before me.
