Imprimis. - I most humbly bequeath my soul to God my Maker.

I give and bequeath unto my son Richard one Hundred acres of land lying in land sides of Duck Horn Branch.

I give and bequeath unto my Son John one Hundred acres of land joining the place where I now live.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Henry one Hundred acres of land where I now live and this Hundred acres my wife to have for life time or widowhood in quietest enjoyment.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary one Acre,

I give and bequeath unto my wife one Acre one Chest and one Wheel.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Henry one set of Blacksmith tools, one Mare named Liger to be sold to pay my debts, the rest of my property to remain with my wife and children until the youngest child comes of age.

I leave Mr. John Baldwin Senr to be the Executor to my last Will and Testament.

I William Sutton of the State of North Carolina and County of Bladen being weak through of sound mind and memory, caring to mind the mortality of the body and knowing that it is once appointed for all men to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament.

Imprimis. - I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and Hoping at the General Resurrection it will receive the same and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I dispose of in manner and form following.

Item. - It is my Will that all my just debts and General Charges be paid.

Thus - I leave my Wife Susannah all my lands and Tenements, with all my household Furniture, Stocks of all kinds and that the said Susannah shall school my young children and keep the family together if they please, and at the death or marriage of my Wife Susannah my land to be equally divided between my three Sons, James, William and Robin. The remainder of my estate to be equally divided amongst my Wife and daughter Anne and Sarah. Catherine and Hope, my daughters to receive their proportionable parts when they arrive at the age of maturity or marry my Wife Susannah's part to be disposed of as she pleases.

And I do appoint my Wife Susannah and my Son James Sutton my Executors to this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal. This 9th of October 1804,
