of Andrew McLean with the further issue
of the said Negro Struck Dower to her and her
heirs forever.

Third

After the death of my wife Elizabeth Lammont
her third as above stated motto Sheep and Rose
it is my desire that it be left to my son Andrew Lammont to be disposed of by him as he may
think most proper.

Fourth

I give to my daughter Margaret Blue

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five pounds North Carolina Currency

& give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine Campbell five pounds North Carolina Currency

& give and bequeath to Mariaus Shadys five
pounds North Carolina Currency

The remainder of my estate both Real and personal
not heretofore settled away I give and bequeath
to my son Andrew Lammont to him his heirs
and assigns forever.

Duncan McColl and David McKeithan Executors
of this my last Will and Testament

Hendon and their and each of their heirs executors and administrators upon their special trust and confidence that they the survivor or survivors of them will hold the said property in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Lydia Campbell during her natural life and should my said daughter need it necessary unto her advantage that any part of the aforesaid property should be sold then and in that case that the aforesaid William Davis, G. White and Wm. Hendon shall sell and dispose of such part as my said daughter may point out the proceeds thereof to be applied as she may direct and after the death of my said daughter Lydia Campbell that the house mentioned above and lot in which I now reside as aforesaid shall be and come to the use of my grand daughter Margaret Campbell and her heirs forever and that the residue of my estate both real and personal shall be and come to the use and benefit of the surviving children of my daughter Lydia Campbell and their heirs forever.

And I do hereby revoke all former will and Wills by me made declaring this to be my only last will and Testament and further appoint the aforesaid William Davis, G. Griffith and William Hendon Executors to the same.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy one shilling sterling to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Aaron one shilling sterling to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Richard one shilling sterling to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Moses one shilling sterling to him his heirs and assigns forever.
