I give to my daughter Margaret Blue

five pounds Sterk Carolina Currency

I give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine Campbell five pounds Sterk Carolina Currency.

I give and bequeath to Mariah Shaw five pounds Sterk Carolina Currency.

Then

The remainder of my estate both Real and personal not heretofore allotted away I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Lammond to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I hereby make and ordain my worthy friends Duncan McLaid and David McKethan Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
