I leave to pay all my lawful debts, and I do give and bequeath unto David Mauley, the Sum of five Shillings

And I do give and bequeath unto Robert Surry the Sum of Five Shillings and I do give and bequeath to John McKay, the Sum of five Shillings

It is also my will that my Executors keep
my negroes on the plantation with all my
stock of every kind and plantations tools &c.

It is also my desire that the Saw mill with
the plantation be worked under the direction
