

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the name of God Amen
 I Stephen Hollingsworth of the County of
 Bladen and State of North Carolina
 being of sound and of perfect mind and
 memory blessed be God do this the fifth
 day of September in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
 and publish this my last will and testament
 in manner and form following that is
 to say

1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
 Mary Hollingsworth my black man Harry
 and my black girl Belah three hundred
 and twenty acres of land on cedar creek
 including my whole plantation four cows
 and calves one hundred and fifty bushels of corn
 twelve killable hogs two sows and pigs
 and one house named Tom to be hered during
 her life and at the death to be equally divided
 among my six children viz
 Becket, Susan, Alexandria, Agustus & Mary
 Margaret Hollingsworth except the land
 And at the death of my wife Mary it is
 my will and desire that the land given to me
 be equally divided between my two sons
 Alexandria and Agustus.

2nd It is my will and desire that my
 executors wher I shall hereafter name see
 on a credit of six months all my stock of
 cattle hogs sheep or mules horses household
 and plantation utensils which have not
 heretofore given away.
 And also see on a credit of twelve months
 and after the first day of March hire
 out all my Negroes on a credit of
 six and twelve months and the pro-
 ce thereof applied to paying my just debt
 and if any over plus to be equally divided
 among my six children above named
 And I give and bequeath any case per acre lands

1st To be equally divided between them
 It is my will and desire that the South river
 miles be repaid and upon such report to be
 sold if thought best by Executress.
 And if not sold it is my will and desire
 that my part of them and the lands belong-
 ing thereto be equally divided between any
 two sons Alexandria and Agustus and
 my four daughters.

2nd It is my will and desire that my Negroes
 be continued to be hired out until my young-
 est child becomes of age and then and
 their increase be equally divided between any
 six children Rebecca J. Hollingsworth Susan
 J. Hollingsworth Alexandria Hollingsworth
 Isabella Hollingsworth Agustus Hollings-
 worth and Mary M. Hollingsworth.

Also I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter
 Rebecca Hollingsworth one bed and furniture.

Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
 Susan one bed and furniture.

Also I give unto my beloved daughter Isabella
 one bed and furniture.

Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
 Mary M. Hollingsworth one bed and furniture.

Also I give unto my beloved wife one bed and
 furniture.

And I hereby appoint my worthy friend Robert
 Melvin or George T. Barksdale Executress
 to this my last will and testament
