Will of Thomas Thomas

In the Name of God Amen. I, Thomas Thomas of the Province of North Carolina & County of Bladen being weak in body but of sound memory (Blessed be God) do this fifth day of March & in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty eight make & publish this my Last Will & Testament in manner following (that is to say) First I give & Bequeath unto my Loving wife Prudence Thomas one Hundred acres of Land Being the Plantation where I now live likewise I give unto her the s^t Prudence Thomas ten Cows & Calves also I give unto my dear wife all the moveables of my Estate Except a Bed & furniture I give to my Daughter Phebe Thomas and to my Daughter M^{rs} Thomas I give a Bed & furniture & a Chest of Drawers The land above mentioned after the decease of my Beloved wife I give & Bequeath unto my son Samuell Thomas & his heirs & assigns forever also to my son Joseph Thomas I give the sum of five shillings. Also I give unto Corn^e Thomas the sum of five shillings Also I give unto my son Thomas Thomas one Hundred acres of Land Lying in the province above s^d & County of Craven on the flat swamp also I give unto my sons John Thomas & Amos Thomas two Hundred & twenty acres of Land Lying on Dunks Creek to be equally divided between each of them Also Eight Head of Cattle to be equally divided between them Each also I give unto my son Samuell Thomas Eight Head of Cattle. Also I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Thomas a Bed, Also I give unto my Daughter Priscilla Lunn the sum of five shillings. And I make & ordain her my above s^d wife Executrix and my son Cornelius Thomas my Executor of this my will in Trust for the intents & purposes in this my will Contained to take Care & see the same performed according to my true intent & meaning.
