I give and bequeath unto my son in law Absal-  
ton King Two hundred acres of land two hundred and fifty  
acres in Bladensburg that whence he now lives. and one  
hundred and fifty acres on the back of Dam Creek

Fifthly  
I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary the  
plantation on which I now live three hundred and thirty  
acres adjoining Justus Spangler's land two hundred and  
fifty acres Bed and Furniture

Sixthly and Lastly. it is my will that the remainder of my Estate  
except one feather Bed for the use of my wife should be  
sold by my Executors for the use of my beloved  
Wife Mary and at her decease if any left the mon-  
ey to be equally divided among my children.

I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Mary my son  
John and my son in law Absalon King my Executors to  
execute this my last will and testament.

calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing  
that it is appointed for all men once to die. do make  
and ordain this my last will and testament that is to  
say principally and first of all. I give and recommend  
my soul into the hands of God that gave it. and for my  
body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a  
Christian like and decent manner at the direction of my  
Executors. Worring doubtless but at the general resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God  
and as touching Sarah Hobbs estate wherewith it has  
pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and  
lend dispose of the same in the following manner  
and form.

In witness whereof I am my first will and I do order that in the first place  
all my just debt and funeral charge be paid and satisfied
