

RECORD OF WILLS.

In the name of God "Amen"

I William Johnson, being in good health and of sound mind and perfect memory, blessed be God, do this 9th day of September, in the year of Our Lord make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the following manner - that is to say -

1st. I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Ann Johnson, the following negroes, during her natural life, to wit, Kiberry, Marcus, Miley, Phoebe, Sabina and Sarah, after her death then the same negroes or such of them as may be remaining in life to be equally divided between my two daughters, viz. Sarah Monroe and Margaret Williams, their heirs and assigns and to my Wife I further leave her during her natural life a tract of land I bought of Stephen Lock, and at her death the said tract of land to go to my son William S. Johnson, his heirs and assigns forever And I further give to my said Wife, one Horse and Chair and Harness, one Yoke of Oxen and one Part One half of my stock of Cattle, Sheep and Hogs, all of my Storehold and Kitchen Furniture, also one half of any money that should be on hand at my death, or should be due me by note account or otherwise, at my death also one half of any provisions on hand, and one half of my Plantation utensils.

I give to my son William S. Johnson, the following negroes, Cuthbert and her eight children to-wit, Jacob, Dick, John, Mary, Dick, Rose and Annina, also any further increase that the said Cuthbert may have.

Also I give to him the following pieces or parts of land. One tract I bought of David Long and Wife as the deed to me will more fully appear One other tract I bought from Curry & Wife as the deed to me will show more fully - One tract I bought of Major John McKay, as his deed to me will show.

One other tract lying on the upper side of the River which I bought of Benjamin Lock as

also one other piece of fifty acres lying in my Swamp joining the lands of Stacey, and four hundred acres of land. One hundred acres of it I bought of David Long beginning at Marnes Camp. The other three hundred acres is patented in my name, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

And also I further give to him my Carpenters tools and Blacksmith tools, and the remaining half of my things, as I have left my wife also my carts and horses, or oxen, that should be on hand at my death except such things as I have left to my wife to him and his heirs forever.

I give to my daughter Sarah Monroe, the following negroes, Jack, Miley, and Jim, to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

I do not hereby give my daughter Sarah any real estate in consequence of having hitherto given her five hundred dollars, in lieu of lands. - I give and grant to my daughter Margaret Williams the following negroes, David, Rachel and her two children, and any increase that the said Rachel may have hereafter.

Also I give her four hundred acres of land lying on Cully Swamp, known by the name of Stacey land. I bought the land from David Long. One other piece of land lying on Cully Swamp just above the Stacey land. One other piece of fifty acres joining the above is called Cully Spring also ten acres lying in Cully, in what is called the dark point. The above property to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby make and ordain my son William S. Johnson, and Colin Monroe, as Executors to this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal, the day and Year first above written.
