First

I give and bequeath to William Johnson Margaret Dranghan and David Lloyd or the survivors of them in trust for the support of my daughter Patey Morgan the following property two beds and furniture, one tea table, four Windsor chairs, one side board, some crockery ware, one large wheel one pair cotton cards, one pair fire dogs, one pair of smoothing irons, four head of cattle and their increase, one small horse kitchen furniture &c and whatever money may be in my possession or owing to me at my decease and after the death of my daughter Patey Morgan I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Margaret Ann Morgan and John Bradley Morgan my grand son the above property to be equally divided between them or such part as may be remaining after the death of my said daughter Patey Morgan to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Secondly

I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Simpson one bed and furniture, one bureau, one folding table, and two Windsor chairs to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

I do appoint and ordain my friends William Johnson, Magazine Dranghan and David Lloyd Executors of this my last will and Testament.
