I give and bequeath to my son Edward Davis one house by the name of School to him & his heirs to enjoy.

I also give & bequeath to my four sons Samuel Davis, Edward Davis & Nathan Davis & Allen Davis with the mill three yds of staves & carriage & all she-entertainment belong to the mill.

And it is my will & desire that all my lands & houses & stocks that I have not already given a to be sold publickly Vandue & also at the death my wife all that I lent her to be Equally Divided Between my sons by Davis & Samuel Davis & Edward Davis & Nathan Davis, Anthony Davis & Allen Davis & Turner Wiley & Clayton & Betsey Davis.

I also constitute and appoint my son Lazarus Davis & Samuel Davis Executors of this my last-will & Testament Revoking all other former Wills made by me at any time before made and acknowledged to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this twentieth day of February 1794

In the Name of God amen I Christopher Dudley of Craven County Being weak in Body but of sound memory Being mind full of Mortality and for the benefit of my family do more than my last will and testament in form following in chief of all I command my sole to God but for it was through the merit of Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my Body to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and for such worldly losses as God hath been pleased to afflict me with I Dispose of as followeth.

First of all I Give to my three sons Elijah, Christopher & Abraham Dudley one tract and plantation of land containing two hundred and fifty acres on the Black Swamp on the East side of White Oak River the maner Plantation I now own Likewise it is my desire that if of either of my above mentioned Sons die without a Lawful issue Begotten of his mortal bodye it is to be Divided between th other two or the longest line of said Sons coming to age to share and their Lawfully Begotten of their bodies for ever.

Also I Give to my three Sons Elijah, Christopher & Abraham Dudley all my carpenters Joiners Copers & Shunmakers tools to be Equally Divided amongst my three Sons at the Electing of age to share and their Ears for ever.

Also I Give to my son Elijah two cows anno Earling to him and his heirs for ever also I Give to my son Christopher two cows to him and his heirs for ever also I Give to my son Abraham one cow to him and his heirs for ever.

also I Give to my Daughter Delilah one feather bed one cow and two heifers to her and her heirs for ever

I also Give to my Daughter Lucy one cow and heifer and one feather bed to her and her heirs for ever

also Give to Daughter Rachel one cow and one feather bed to her and her heirs for ever

also I send to my beloved wife Susannah Dudley all the rest of my estate that not will excepting a Whippoor will & an two hens and my part of the land marsh living his widow hood such as plantation tools horses cattle hogs and sheep Likewise one Negro man and household furniture to bring up my children with proper leave at the Discretion of my Executors and likewise at my desire but after my beloved wife Death or marriage to be Equally Divided Between my three sons and three daughters to share and their Ears and assigns for ever. I also desire that my Executors sign a Deed to John Stankey for my

part of an islande march in the mouth of White Oak River I also bear to my storer son Elias White & Abraham Dudley for their one proper use one which one comes last saw two tens I also nominate and appoint John Shepard Solomon Shepard and Joseph Whorton Executors of this my last will and testament Revoking all other and former wills by me at any time before made and I also edge this to be my last will and testamant in witness whereof I have set my hand and first my seal this Day of 28 of Feb: anno domini 1774

In the name of god a men is to say I John Dickinson of the County of Beaufort and State of North Carolina planter being of perfect mind and memory shalke he to god for it knowinge calling unto minde the mortallitie of my body I knowinge shalke it is appointed for all men once to dy marr or die and appint this my last will and testamant that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my self into the hands of almighty god that gave it unto me my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent maner at the discretion of my Executours Nothing Doubting But at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by almighty power of god as touching such worldly Estate wher with it hath pleased god to place me with in this life I give Divers and Diuers of the same in the following maner and form as I give and bequeath unto my son James Dickinson fifty acres of Land lying and Being on the head of Cox Creek Bindings on a mountain Brdy and cutting sedy so calle I give and bequeath unto my son John Dickinson fifty acres of Land being out of the patent of Land lying between junction Brdy and the hasey Branch I give unto my son James Dickinson and son John Dickinson fifty acres of Land lying on the head of the said Land & being in the Equally Dividell Between them and I give unto my son John all my shooting tools of every sort and I give and bequeath all the rest of my good and Chatteles in Goods and out Goods Between James Dickinson Marster priuer many wifes Sarah Neggs John Dickinson Nancy Bond etc his good and Chatteles to be sold at publick sale according to Law and the money to be Equally Devised Between them all the above mentioned Children in the name of our Lord one Eighteen hundred Six and Delivred in the present of - and Testimone I give and bequeath unto my son James Dickinson fourteen acres of Land wher my son James now lies Being peace that James Dickinson stirs up and I likewise bear my son James and John to be my Executors the 27 of august eighteen hundred Six and Delivred in present of
