 & his heirs all my Lands and all the Remainder of my
 Estate &c.

Lastly I do Nominate & appoint my son James to be my Executor in Trust of my Last will and Testament Making Null & Void all other wills by me before made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th of January one thousand Seven hundred and sixty

son Rowland Simpson one shilling prock drinking & heavy sufficiently
wrought for each of them. Fourthly, I give unto my wife Sarah Simpson
all and every of my household goods and cutchells for house keeping
and my linen and all my implements for tanning. Fifthly, I give to my
son Joseph Simpson all my estate of the farm as well allowing his mother
the male until he is Seventy years of age and then half of the male
estate for to be appropriated to the use of my son J^r Simpson and
lastly I give unto my son Joseph Simpson the plantation whereon I now
live and all the land share unto belonging being in all one hundred and
sixty Eight Acres his heirs Executors, Adminis^r or assigns for ever
but always and for ever excepting the burying place where my wife
Jane lyeth being 40 foot square beginning at a great stone near the
grove the lying into the Northern and Western part of the said plot of
land, and lastly I Nominate and appoint to be Executors to
this my last will Mr Michael Pagnanott and my John Carter and
my wife Sarah.
