Secondly, I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Nisiah
Buchanan (Widow) one Negro Girl named Pack, also all
my lands in the County of Kentucky in the State of
Virginia to her and her Heirs for ever
Thirdly, I Give and bequeath unto Margaret Williams Wife
of Lemuel Williams one Negro Girl named Cate, also
the Tract of Land whereon the said Williams now lives
it being the Land I purchased of Nathaniel Hall, lying
