residue of my Estate goods Chattels moving appur-  
tenant to my dear beloved sister Lucy Thompson  
whom I nominate, constitute and appoint sole  
executrix of this my last will & Testament hereby  
revoking all other and former wills by me at any  
time heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal, the twenty first day of  
July in the year of our Lord one thousand & eight  
hundred & twenty nine.

In the name of God Amen I Henry Evans of Currituck  
County and State of North Carolina being weak in body  
but sound in mind and in my perfect sense calling  
to mind that it is appointed for all men to die so  
make and Establish this my last will and testa-  
ment in manner as follows first I give and beque-  
ath unto my son Jeptha Evans my Young House  
to him I bid his head forever.

Item I give unto my wife Edney Evans all of  
my property Land or what come over of every  
kind without doors and within during of her  
natural life or widowhood.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jeptha  
Evans my mare after my wifes death or marriage  
unto him his head forever. Now if my mare  
should bring the foal she is with that she is now  
with foal shall it be my will and desire that  
my son Jeptha Evans should take his choice  
of the two and the other I Give to my son James  
Evans and his head forever.

Item 4. I Give & bequeath unto my son Jeptha Evans  
six Minsgo. Chink after my wifes death or marriage  
unto him his head forever.

Item 5. It is my will & desire that the bell I be steeled  
that was given to my son Jeptha by his Grandfather  
that he shall take it in possession immediately  
after my death.

Item 6. It is my will & desire that the Rijer that  
my father gave to my daughter Sally that she should  
take it in possession immediately after my death.

Item 7. I Give & bequeath to my son James Evans one  
feather Bed and one Iron Pot I lent to him  
when he was married to him and his heirs  
for ever. Item 8. I Give unto my daughter  
Sally one feather bedstead & furniture sayth to be  
laid in.

Item 9. I Give unto my daughter Milly Evans one  
Feather bedstead & furniture the bed &  
one rug & ship one Earthen Puffe white &  
red Colours one Linen the big chest & my old  
kitchen wheel to her & her heirs for ever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my daughter Ann Evans One Linnen Wheel that she has already in Possession & her heirs here forever  
 Item I give also unto my daughter Sally my new Linnen Wheel to her & her heirs forever  
 Item 11th I Give & bequeath unto my two sons James & Jesse Evans my Land whereon I now live to be in equal division ~~between~~<sup>among</sup> in the Cleared Land for James to have the western end and Jesse the Eastward End with the dwelling House and as to Wood Land Leaving a Marsh it is my will & desire it should be divided Eastwardly & Westwardly and my son James to have the North side of my Wood Land.

Item 12th it is my will & desire that all the Property I have not already given away at the death or marriage of my wife should be sold to pay my debts and the remainder to be in equal division between my three daughters say Ann Evans, Sally Evans and Malley Evans after all I nominate & appoint my wife Edney Evans Executrix to this my last will and Testament this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1836.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one feather bed & one Linnen wheel

Item I also give to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one four foot chest forever

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Edney Simmons one feather bed that stands in any hall room forever

Item I give & bequeath to my son Anthony Simmons one pair of Study desks and one huckle forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Bell and grand daughter Polly S Etheridge my cart & riding chain to be equally divided between them their heirs forever

Item I give to my son Anthony Simmons one table cloth to him & his heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Bell one table cloth to her & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one table cloth to her & her heirs forever

Item I leave all the residue of my property to be sold to pay my debts and expenses of my funeral and if there be any left after that to be divided between my son Anthony Simmons & Sarah Bell & Polly S Etheridge
