this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following Viz. I give and bequeath unto
my dear sister Eliza Thompson of the land
where I now live adjoining the lands of John
Williams, Samuel Thompson and John Mathias
I also give and bequeath all the rest and
residue of my Estate goods, Chattels moving appan-
el &c to my dear beloved sister Eliza Thompson
whom I nominate, constitute and appoint sole
executrix of this my last will & Testament hereby
revoking all other and former wills by me at any
time heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal, the thirty first day of
July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
and thirty nine.

In the name of God Amen I Henry Evans of Currituck
County and State of North Carolina being weak in body
but sound in mind and in my perfect senses calling
to mind that it is appointed for all men to die do
make and establish this my last will and testa-
ment in manner as follows first I give and bequeath
unto my son Jesse Evans my young horse
to him and his heirs forever.

2^d Item I leave unto my wife Emily Evans all of
my property land or what come over of every
kind without deed and within living of her
natural life or Widowhood.
3^d Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse
Evans my mare after my wife's death or marriage
unto him & his heirs forever. Now if my mare
should bring the foal she is with that she should
with foal ~~she~~ it is my will and desire that
my son Jesse Evans should take his choice
of the two and the other I give to my son James
Evans and his heirs forever.

Item 4. I give & bequeath unto my son Jesse Evans
his Minor Child after my wife's death or marriage
unto him & his heirs forever.

Item 5. It is my will & desire that the bee I bea bea
that was given to my son Jesse by his Grandfather
that he shall take it in possession immediately
after my death.

Item 6. It is my will & desire that the Rifer that
my father gave to my daughter Sally that she should
take it in possession immediately after my death.

Item 7. I leave & bequeath to my son James Evans one
feather bed and one Iron Pot I lent to him
when he was married to him and his heirs
for ever.

Item 8. I leave unto my daughter
Sally one feather bedstead & furniture say the two she
has in.

Item 9. I leave unto my daughter Sally Evans one
feather bedstead & furniture & furniture the bed &
and my wife's sheep one one Earthen Doffer white &
red colour one Loom the big chest & my old
broom wheel to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Ann Evans One Linen Wheel Thus she has already in Possession & her heirs forever.

Item I give also unto my daughter Sally my new Linen Wheel to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two sons James & Jesse Evans my Land where our ranch lies to the an equal division ~~among~~ in the Cleared Land for James to have the western ends and Jesse the Eastern End with the dwelling House and as to wood Land I want & mark it is my will & desire it should be divided Eastwardly & Westwardly and my son James to have the north side of my wood Land.

Item 15th it is my will & desire that all the Property I have not already given away at the death or marriage of my wife it should be sold & pay my debts and the remainder to be an equal division between my three daughters Mary Ann Owens Sally Evans and Melly Evans after all I nominate appoint my wife Edney Evans Executor to this my last will and Testament this 13th day of February 1834.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Pell the second third of my cattle.

Item I give and bequeath to my granddaughter Helen Polly D. Etheridge the last third of my cattle forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly D. Etheridge one feather bed & one Linen wheel.

Item I also give to my grand daughter Polly D. Etheridge one four foot chest forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Edney Simmons one feather bed that stands in my hall room forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Anthony Simmons one pair of study aids and one hackle forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Pell and grand daughter Polly D. Etheridge my cart & riding chain to be equally divided between and their heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Anthony Simmons one table cloth to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Pell one table cloth to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly D. Etheridge one table cloth to her & her heirs forever.

Item I leave all the residue of my property to be sold to pay my debts and expenses of my funeral and if there be any left after that to be divided between my son Anthony Simmons & Sarah Pell & Polly D. Etheridge.
