Therefor calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it appertaineth for all men once to die I do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul to the hands of God that gave it and for my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Exes nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall have the same again my the mighty power of God astounding worldly estate herewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life. I give and leave to my son John Bird one hundred acres of land with the plantations whereon I now live and one negro boy name Liles an one cow and yearling and one horse colt name Major to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give to my well beloved son Michael Bird one negro girl name Tyles and one cow and yearling and one mule gray and a mare colt name much to him and his heirs for ever Item I give to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth Bird one mulatto girl name Clara one thin cow and
