lawful

shall fall to my son Johannes and his Heirs Law-
fully Begotten for Ever

Item - I give to my son Eliza Sellers to Value of five
Shillings

Item - I give to my son Benj^m Sellers to Value of five
Shillings and I do hereby constitute ordain and
make my Wife and William Dorseth my only and
sole Ex^{ors} of this my last Will and Testament
and the Remaining Part of my Estate I do Leave
to be Equally Divided between my Wife and her
Children now living with her and I do hereby
Disallow revoke and annul all and every
Other former Testaments Wills Legacies Bequests
& Grants by me in any ways before this time
made made and Bequeathed Ratified and Con-
firming this to be my last Will and
Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and Seal this Third day of January 1761
