Expecting Life through the Merits of Jesus Christ my Mediator and Redeemer
and for my Temporal Estate which with it hath pleased
I give my Bequeath as followeth after my Just Debts Paid
I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah one and a half Shilling
Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Son Vandyke one Shilling
Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary one Shilling
Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Son Zachariah one
Shilling Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Son Richard one
Shilling Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Son Paul
one Shilling Sterling I give and Bequeath to my Son
Zachariah one Shilling Sterling I give and Bequeath to
my Daughter Vandyke one feather bed and furniture to the
Value of eight pounds Virginia Money I give and Bequeath to
my Son Zachariah one feather Bed and furniture to
the Value of eight Pounds Virginia Money I give and Bequeath
to my Daughter Agatha one Shilling Sterling my will
and desire is that my Land or Slaves Credit or other things
be sold to pay part of my debts and the Land and other things
whereas I now live to my wife during her Natural life likewise
all the Remainder of my Estate after my Just Debts is paid I
give and Bequeath to my Son Richard Bullock after my wife
