think proper to leave thus following him as my last Will & Testament
Principally & first of all I recommend my Soul to God who gave it
and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named — And as touching
what worldly substance it has pleased God to bless me with it
is my will to dispose of in the following Manner viz

- 1st. I give & bequeath to my beloved wife son Andrew Rufus the Plantation
whereon he now lives as it now stands divided or laid off to him & his heirs forever
- 2nd. I give & bequeath to son Daniel Rufus, the Plantation whereon he now
lives as it stands divided or laid off to him & his heirs forever
- 3rd. I give & bequeath to my son James Rufus, Ten Dollars to be paid out
of my Estate After the death of my wife.
- 4th. I give & bequeath to my son Elijah Rufus, One hundred & fifty thousand
of land adjoining Moses Barner's lands Charles Clements lands & Temple
Ballingue's lands to him & his heirs forever
- 5th. I give & bequeath to my house wife Sarah Rufus, the use & benefit of the
whole Plantation whereon I now live, my Mans Name &c, Two Pairs
the choice of my Stock, four Hogs the choice, four Sheep her choice, also
Two beds & their furniture, One Pewter dish, & two Pewter plates, & as much
of the Kitchen furniture as she may think proper for during her natural life
And all the balance of my Estate After paying my just debts & funeral
expenses to be sold & equally divided between my five daughters, Namely
Mary, Elizabeth, Nancy, Sarah, & Anna except Sarah is to have
Thirty Dollars less than the others as she has hitherto had more than
the others — And at the death of my wife Sarah Rufus the
Plantation left for her use and all the other property, that may
remain, at that time to be sold and the money equally divided
between my five aforesaid daughters.

Lastly I will & appoint my two beloved sons Andrew Rufus & Danl
Rufus, Executors of this my last Will & Testament Ratify, & following
whatever they may lawfully do or cause to be done in settling which
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 21st day of October 1828.

Two beds & their furniture, One Pewter dish, & six Pewter plates, & as much
of the Kitchen furniture as she may think proper for & during her natural life

And all the balance of my Estate after paying my just debts & funeral
expenses to be sold & equally divided between my five daughters, namely

Mary, Elizabeth, Nancy, Sarah, & Anna all except Sarah is to have

Thirty Dollars less than the others as she has hitherto had more than
the others — And at the death of my wife Sarah Rufus the

Plantation left for her use and all the others property, that may
remain, at that time to be sold and the money Equally divided

between my five aforementioned daughters.
